Early evening the consultation ended without any harm and further disturbances happened in the facility. With regards to the clients, they were accommodated according to their needs and conditions.

We were very grateful and glad that the consultations ended without any harm inflicted but ended with satisfaction to the treatment given and understanding between us caregivers and to each patient.
