The legendary Glenn Miller was one of the most successful of all dance bandleaders back in the Swing Era of the 1930's and 40's. A matchless string of hit records, constant broadcasts on the radio, and frequenting of theatres, hotels and dance pavilions, built and sustained his popularity. At the height of his fame in 1942, Glenn volunteered for the Army. There, he organized and led the famous Glenn Miller Army Air Force Band to entertain servicemen across Europe, performing numerous live and radio shows. On December 15, 1944, Major Miller took off in a single engine plane to precede his band to France, disappearing over the English Channel, never to be seen again. The army declared him officially dead a year later.

With the release of the major motion movie The Glenn Miller Story in 1954, interest and popular demand led the Miller Estate to authorize the formation of the present Glenn Miller Orchestra. Today, the 18 member ensemble continues to play many of the original Miller arrangements both from the civilian band and the AAFB libraries, like "Moonlight Serenade," "Little Brown Jug" and "Chattanooga Choo Choo." Additionally, it also plays some more modern selections arranged and performed in the Miller style and sound. Just as it was in Glenn's day, the Glenn Miller Orchestra today is still the most sought after Big Band in the world.

97 James Suckling; 94 Wine Advocate. Beautifully rich and layered, extremely fine and long finish. The flagship wine of this Napa family, Quintessa is a Meritage style blended red. Each year, it can include some or all of the varietals grown on the estate. Robert Parker scored this 2014 94 points saying "The three red wines are represented best by the flagship wine, the 2014 Quintessa Proprietary Red from their vineyards in Rutherford. A beautiful floral, black raspberry and blackcurrant nose soars from this dense ruby/purple wine. Medium-bodied, beautifully rich and layered... wonderfully supple, lush tannins. This wine has great balance, purity, and presence on the palate and should evolve beautifully for two decades or more." James Suckling scored it 97 points saying "Aromas of spearmint, sweet tobacco, cigars and blackcurrants follow through to a medium to full body, very polished and refined tannins and an intense finish. "

Earned 93 pts in Robert Parker's The Wine Advocate: "Containing just 7% Petit Verdot, the 2015 Cabernet Sauvignon Blueprint sports a deep garnet-purple color and fragrant notes of fresh blackberries and black currants, mulberries, with bay leaves and sandalwood in the background. Medium to full-bodied, the palate features a good core of muscular, expressive fruit, supported by grainy tannins, finishing long and nicely poised. "

6-W Husic Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon 2012

On the Husic's hillside property, overlooking the Stags Leap District of Napa Valley, Julie and Frank set out to realize a life-long dream. In 1997, moving endless rocks and sculpting narrow terraces that cling to the mountain's edge, they planted three small, extremely steep Cabernet Sauvignon vineyards, which peacefully coexist with the region's wildlife. The rugged, rocky growing conditions, combined with careful farming methods, have yielded a limited amount of magnificent fruit. Now on their twelfth release, they offer the 2012 Husic Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon.

7-W Blackbird Vineyards Contrarian 2014

Opening Bid: \$70; Estimated Value: \$135

Bold and expressive with aromas of black cherry, fresh cracked pepper, and bay leaves, Contrarian is sure to impress. Notes of black currant, blackberry, salted caramel, and sweet herbs are complemented by intrepid tannins that carry through to a long, lingering finish. This wine is stunning now and will continue to develop with time in the cellar. Earned 93 points in Robert Parker's Wine Advocate: "Another stunner is the 2014 Proprietary Red Contrarian, dominated by its 81% Cabernet Sauvignon followed by 13% Merlot and 6% Cabernet Franc. This exhibits classic tobacco leaf, crème de cassis, forest floor, Christmas fruitcake, cedarwood and a touch of new saddle leather. It is full-bodied, powerful, rich, concentrated and yet soft enough to drink now or be cellared for another 15-20 years".

An outstanding white, the 2014 Crozes Hermitage la Mule Blanche is made from equal part Roussanne and Marsanne that spent nine months in 15% new French oak. Offering up lots of buttered citrus, lychee nut and white flowers, it's medium-bodied, fresh and lively, with solid fruit and the overriding elegance that's become the hallmark of the estate. It is grouped here with a Rhone-style red blend of 55% Grenache, 22% Mourvedre, 18% Syrah, and 5% Petite Sirah, which boasts a denseliqueur-like ripeness. Blackberries, black cherries and boysenberries feature, with black pepper, cardamom, licorice, ginger and coriander notes. A striking Napa Marsanne rounds out the trio, aromatic in caramel and oak, it's also ripe and lemony with traces of tropical fruit and vanilla.

Its great presence in mouth is reinforced by fullness, power, and coolness that perfectly harmonize. 92 Points Robert Parker Wine Advocate.

16-W Paso Robles Cabernet Sauvignon and Monterey Chardonnay

Opening Bid: \$20; Estimated Value: \$50

The nose on this 2012 Maddalena Paso Robles Cabernet Sauvignon is fairly light, with tangy blackberry and graphite aromas most prominent. The palate is framed by a chalky tannins and a strong acidity, with more blackberry juice flavors and the slightest touch of tobacco. It is paired here with the 2015 San Simeon Chardonnay. A rich, mouth-filling wine with ripe tropical fruit flavors with complements of citrus and pear. The nose reveals bright fruit and oak toast with hints of vanilla and spice. Mineral notes express the rocky terroir of the vineyards. This structured and well-balanced wine shows a lengthy finish with potential to age.

A stunning duo to cellar or savor. The Dariush Cabernet Sauvignon earned 95 points Wine Enthusiast, and was in their Top 100 of 2015, Cellar Selection. Smoky leather and cigar make for a formidable entry on the nose before huge, layered tannins rise to the fore. A balance of acidity and brightness lurks beneath the weight, rounded by succulent blackberry and black cherry. Cellar through 2022. It is paired here with the Champagne Mallard Rose - a perfect partner for your Springs, your Summers, your celebrations and your romances. Its faintly coppery pink colour, red fruit aromas and its finesse make this a superbly elegant Champagne. Fresh enough to make a lovely aperitif, this wine is also excellent with shellfish and lighter meat dishes as well as red fruit based desserts.

This striking Rose is not commercially available, and comes from a small stock that is marketed only from the winery. These two bottles represent a labor of love by Melinda Taplia, who lost her battle with cancer before the grapes were harvested. For many years, Melinda dreamed of making a dry, salmon-colored rose. She began this project during the later months of her life, and passed away before seeing it completed.. The direction she set has shaped everything from the label to the wine's style - a field blend of Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon that has structure while preserving fresh aromatics. A portion of this very worthy label's proceeds fund breast cancer research.
