

UNISPORT AUSTRALIA (UNISPORT) GUIDELINE Orienteering

Men and women (2019)

UniSport Australia (UniSport) orienteering competitions are conducted in accordance with the rules of the <u>International Orienteering Federation</u> (IOF) except where these differ from UniSport competition guidelines; in which case the latter shall take precedence.

Individual entry

- 1.1. There is no maximum limit on the number of competitors that can enter the events.
- 1.2. At least four universities need to fulfil the minimum entry qualifications for the event to be recognised as a UniSport Nationals competition.
- 1.3. For a university to be eligible to win the championship pennant they must enter a minimum of two competitors in the sprint category (per gender).

Competition format

- 1.4. The competition will comprise of the sprint category for both men and women.
- 1.5. The competition will be conducted externally as a part of a single event hosted by the national/state sporting organisation as published on the UniSport event calendar.
- 1.6. Participants must check the 'UniSport Nationals' tick box and enter their university and student number upon registration into the event for their result to count towards the championship.
- 1.7. The general format and conduct of the events will be contested under the rules of the specific event organisers.

Point score

1.8. Points will be allocated to the top eight places only based on the below pointscore table:

| Place | Individual events points |
|-------|--------------------------|
| 1 | 9 |
| 2 | 7 |
| 3 | 6 |
| 4 | 5 |
| 5 | 4 |
| 6 | 3 |
| 7 | 2 |
| 8 | 1 |



- 1.9. The men and women's overall champion universities will be the university with the greatest combined total point score at the completion of the competition.
- 1.10. In the instance that two or more universities are tied on the same point score at the completion of the competition, the university with the highest place will be ranked above the other university/ies.
