Item	Minutes
Welcome & Introductions	Anne opened the meeting by welcoming everyone to the fifth Stakeholder Group meeting and asked if everyone could introduce themselves. Minutes of previous meeting were read and agreed with no matters arising.
Launch Event Feedback	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Group members spent some time reflecting on the launch of the neighbourhood plan and all agreed the event was a major success. • Attendance on the day (98 adults/ 88 children) and engagement levels with partners was very high. This resulted in lots of positive discussions around the neighbourhood plan, interest shown in local developments and connections made on the day. • 25 of the Springhall Community Centre surveys were also completed on the day • It was also recognized that residents attending the event seemed to now have a familiarity with OPOP and local developments, with conversations continuing on from previous events • A digital version of the neighbourhood plan is now available and to be shared as widely as possible.

<p>Participatory Budgeting – progress so far and new proposals</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Anne reminds the group of the successful participatory budgeting event last year where £16,000 of funding was allocated to the community. <p>Anne updates on discussions and decisions made at the Environmental and community safety working group meeting.</p> <p>The group look over progress of PB projects and new proposals (document attached).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Skips: Cost of skips approved by Working group. Anne will take forward the proposal of 8 skips to be located in various locations to be identified by residents. - SCRG launch events: Approved by working group. The resource group will host 2 launch events on physical improvement developments - WCRC: Approved by working group. Funds requested to renew external cladding, repair gate, supply and fit of new signage. - Duke of Edinburgh Group: Approved by working group. - Garden tool library: Group discuss the potential of a garden tool hire scheme. Further discussion needed around cost and logistics. - RegenFX: Kim presents a proposal to hire a room within WCRC as a dedicated youth space. This idea was welcomed by the stakeholder group. <p>All costings to be collated for proposals and remainder of funds to be allocated to dedicated youth space proposal.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Anne informs the group that there is potential for more funding to be made available this year for further participatory budgeting events.
<p>A.O.C.B.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The group look over terms of reference and agree changes to the frequency of meetings. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - stakeholder meetings will now take place every 6 weeks, Tuesdays, 4.30pm. - Working group meetings will now take place every 2 weeks, Tuesdays, 3.30pm. <p>Minutes also to be shared within a week of meetings</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Anne updates on the research currently being carried out in Springhall and Whitlawburn by Glasgow University students on the access to food in priority areas. Consultation with local residents in the near future could also potentially take place.
