GETTING TO KYIV

NSC Olimpiyskiy is ideally located in Kyiv's city centre, with multiple metro lines running close to the stadium. It is a 15-minute walk from the Champions Festival and the fan meeting points and a 30-minute walk from the city's main railway hub and its main tourist attractions.

By plane
KYIV BORISPYL AIRPORT (KBP)

Kyiv's main international airport has good connections to most European hubs and is approximately 40km from the city centre. For the final, a special free shuttle bus will operate between Terminal D and the Boryspil'ska metro station from 07.00 to 21.00 on 25 and 27 May, departing every 15 minutes. From there, visitors can use the city's metro network to reach their destination. Special arrangements will be made for charter flights arriving at Boryspil Airport on matchday (see section on fan meeting points for details).

ZHULYANY AIRPORT (IEV)

Passengers arriving at this international airport can use trolleybus line 9 to reach the city centre (journey time of approximately 30 minutes).

By Train
High-speed trains will take you to Kyiv from the country's other main cities in four to seven hours. It is worth noting that Ukraine has good night trains, which are a decent alternative to a hotel in the city. With the city's main railway hub a 30-minute walk from the stadium, you might want to consider accommodation in other cities, such as Lviv or Odesa. Travelling to Ukraine by train may well involve a very long journey, so you will need to take this into account when planning your trip.

By car
Supporters travelling by car from Lviv, Poland or western Europe should use the M-06 or M-07 motorways to get to Kyiv; fans coming from Odesa and the south should take the M-05; and people coming from the north and the east should use the M-01 and M-03. However, owing to the special public transport arrangements in place, there will be no car parks for spectators around the stadium.

Travel tips
- Plan to arrive early on matchday so you can enjoy the Champions Festival before the game.
- Travel light. Big bags and backpacks cannot be taken into the stadium. You can leave them in bag deposit facilities at fan meeting points.
- Plan to be at the stadium at 18.45, in time for the opening of the gates, so you do not miss any of the pre-match ceremony.
- After the match, stay and enjoy everything the city has to offer; most bars and restaurants will remain open all night.

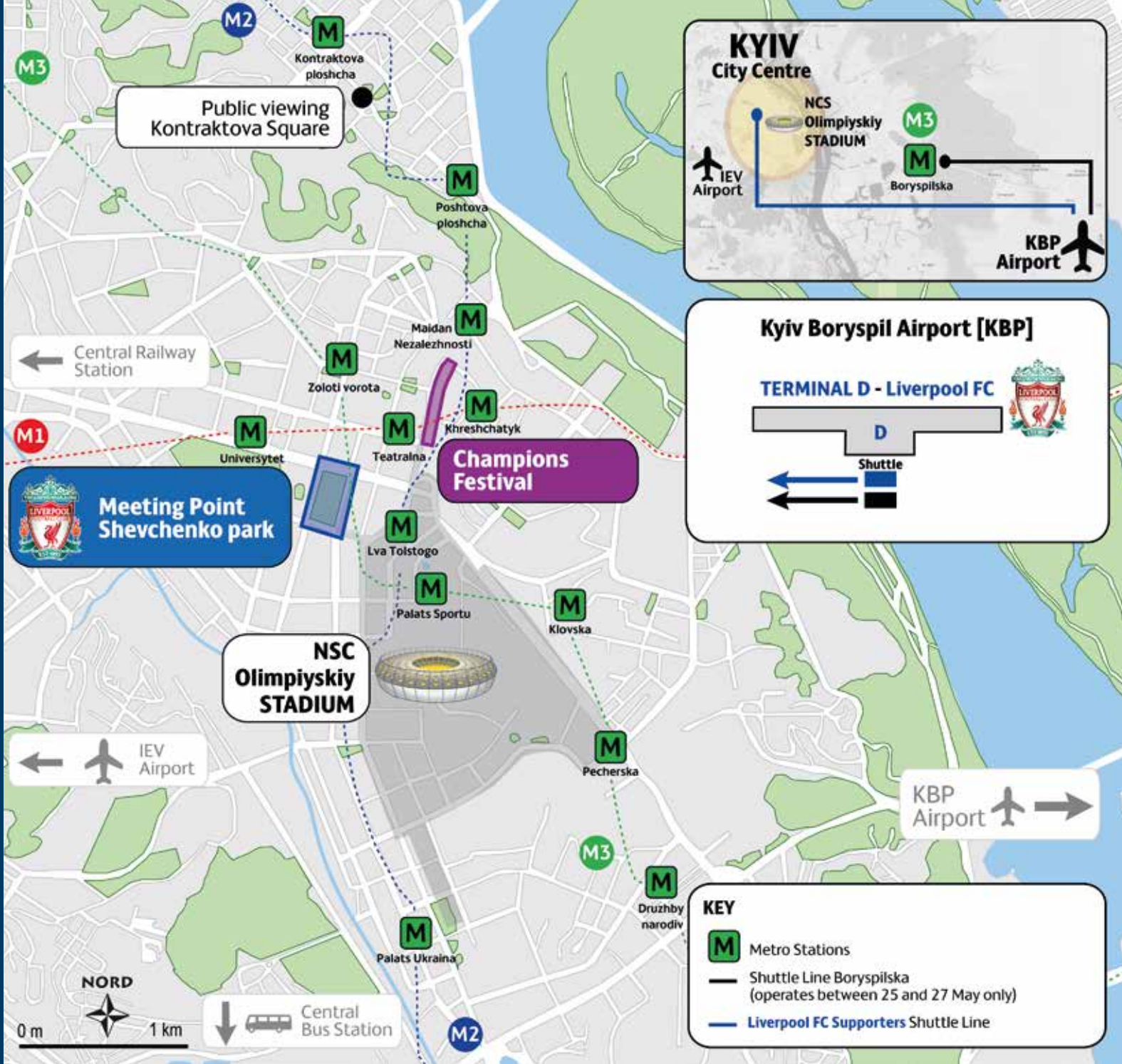
GETTING AROUND KYIV

Walking
Kyiv city centre is a great place to walk around on the day of the final. The fan meeting points are well located in terms of proximity to local transport hubs and places of interest, the Champions Festival and the stadium. The Champions Festival is located in the heart of the city centre, on Khreshchatyk Street.

Public transport
Special arrangements have been made, allowing all ticket holders to use municipal public transport free of charge on the day of the match. This will give fans an excellent opportunity to travel around the city, experiencing Kyiv's top tourist destinations.

Taxi/Uber
Taxis are a convenient way of getting around in Kyiv. A taxi from Boryspil Airport to the city centre will take 30–40 minutes and cost UAH 400 (€15). Taxis may accept credit cards, but this needs to be agreed when making the booking. Taxis can be booked using the Uklon app.

Taxis and private hire vehicles are not allowed inside the stadium's security perimeter. Drop-off and pick-up points for taxis and private hire vehicles can be found on Antonovycha St (for western gates), Baseyna St (for northern gate) and Taras Shevchenko Blvd (for northern gate and the Champions Festival).



UEFA CHAMPIONS FESTIVAL

The UEFA Champions Festival will be located in Kyiv's magnificent city centre. With more entertainment, music and football activities than ever before, this will be the place to be in Kyiv during the week of the UEFA Champions League final.

The festival is free to attend and will give visitors the chance to enjoy a real Champions League experience in one of the most passionate sporting cities in the world. Here are a few of the highlights:

- Come and enjoy the Champions Festival opening ceremony, which will take place on Thursday 24 May 2018 at 10.00 and will include the arrival of the trophy.
- Have your photo taken with the Champions League trophy in the Ultimate Stage Star Ball Dome against the impressive backdrop of Khreshchatyk Street.

- Visit the UEFA Champions Gallery to watch some iconic moments from Champions League finals of the past – both men's and women's – and see a display featuring the shirts of the 32 clubs in the group stage of this season's Champions League.
- Meet former stars of the Champions League at one of the ambassador autograph signing sessions.
- Watch the UEFA Ultimate Champions Tournament (from 16.00 on Friday 25 May), which will feature Champions League stars of the past going head to head in a five-a-side tournament on the UEFA Champions Pitch.
- Enjoy some of Kyiv and Ukraine's best local DJs, bands and performers on the festival's main stage.
- Watch some of the best young footballers

from around the world at the adidas Young Champions Tournament on Friday 25 May.

- Put your skills to the test in football activities organised by Champions League partners and pit yourself against world-renowned football freestylers.

Try to win incredible prizes and bag some fun Champions League souvenirs for all the family.

The Champions Festival will be open from Thursday 24 May to Sunday 27 May at the following times:

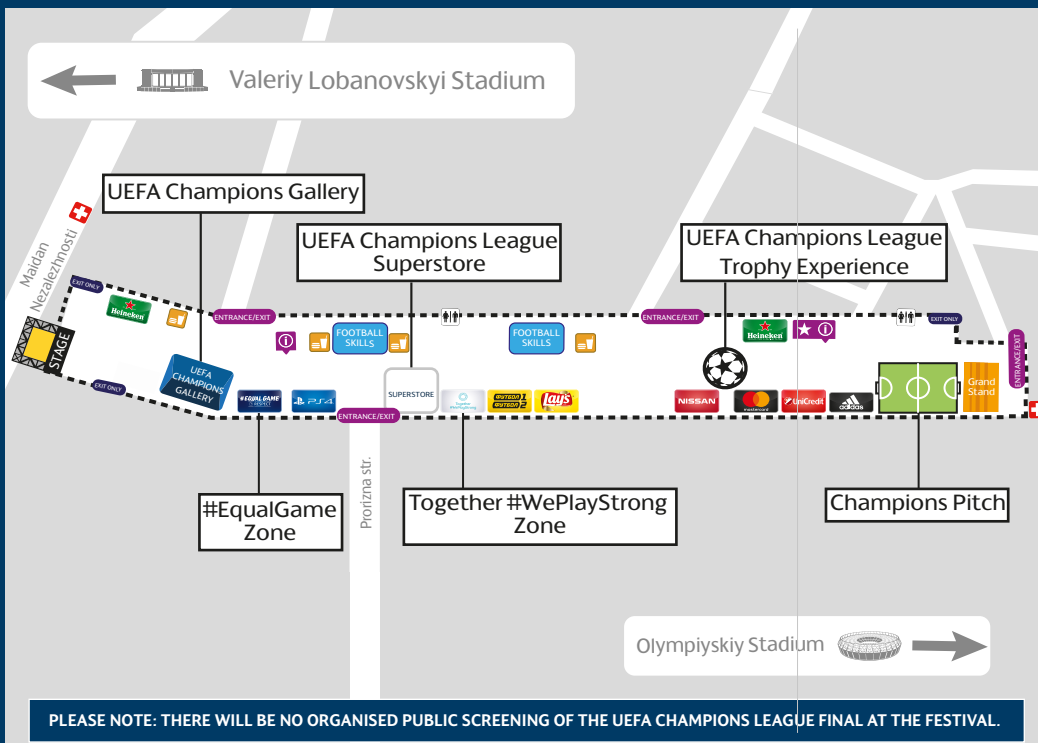

TOP 10 IN KYIV

- Andriyivsky Uzviz**
Nicknamed the 'Montmartre of Kyiv', this street is one of the Ukrainian capital's cultural gems. With numerous galleries and workshops, Andriyivsky Uzviz has always been home to Kyiv's artists.
- Delicious Ukrainian cuisine**
While you're in Kyiv, you simply have to try Ukraine's traditional varenyky (filled dumplings) and the legendary borshch (red beetroot soup).
- City of Golden Domes**
Visitors will marvel at the beauty of the Kyevo-Pecherska Lavra monastery complex and the grandeur of St Sophia's Cathedral, both of which are UNESCO World Heritage Sites.
- Outdoors fun along the Dnipro**
Kyiv straddles the river Dnieper, which divides the city in two. Truhaniv Island is a perfect spot for a relaxing walk or a bike ride. You can also take a cruise on a riverboat for spectacular views of the hills around Kyiv.
- Gigantic Soviet monuments**
Kyiv was the third-largest city in the Soviet Union, so it's no wonder that Soviet heritage can be found pretty much everywhere. You can't miss the enormous Rodina Mat ('Motherland') memorial, which stands 102m tall and is a distinctive feature of Kyiv's skyline.
- Rich entertainment scene**
Kyiv is a vibrant capital city with a wide range of events taking place every day.
- One of Europe's largest open-air museums**
The Pyrohovo Museum of Folk Architecture is the perfect place to find out how Ukrainians have lived over the centuries. With 300 examples of folk architecture from all over Ukraine and more than 40,000 traditional household objects, Pyrohovo is a one-of-a-kind outdoor museum experience.
- Ukrainian Art Nouveau**
Kyiv's eclectic cityscape makes it a perfect destination for architecture lovers. Kyiv's 'modern architectural style' is the equivalent of western Europe's art nouveau. Its pioneer was Wladislaw Horodecki, who gave us the stunning neo-moorish Actor's House, as well as one of Kyiv's most enigmatic landmarks, the splendid House of Chimeras.
- Monumental Kyiv metro**
From colourful frescoes depicting medieval Kyiv Rus heritage at Zoloti Vorota station to white marble busts of scientists and poets at Universytet station – Kyiv's metro is truly vimpresive. It's also record-breaking, with Arsenalna station considered the world's deepest.
- Football festivals and events**
The Champions Festival is located on Khreshchatyk Street and is free to attend. There will also be a giant Champions League trophy at St Sophia Square.

At the various sites across Kyiv's city centre, you will find special photo points. Take photos and upload them to a special website to be in with a chance of winning fantastic prizes! QR codes at those photo points will provide all the information you need.



IN THE STADIUM

Stadium information

Please follow the signs and enter the stadium at the entrance shown on the map on your ticket in order to get to your designated seat. You should plan to arrive at the stadium by 19.45 to allow time for the extensive ticket and security checks.

The stadium gates will open at 18.45, with kick-off at 21.45 (local time).

That opening time may be subject to change, for security reasons.

Please travel light. Bags and backpacks which are larger than 20x25x45cm will not be allowed into the stadium, and neither will plastic or glass bottles.

Please keep your ticket in a safe place and have it ready for inspection as you approach the stadium.

Lost or stolen tickets will not be replaced, and holders of counterfeit tickets will not be allowed into the stadium.

Please also carefully read the terms and conditions printed on the back of your ticket.

Stadium rules and regulations

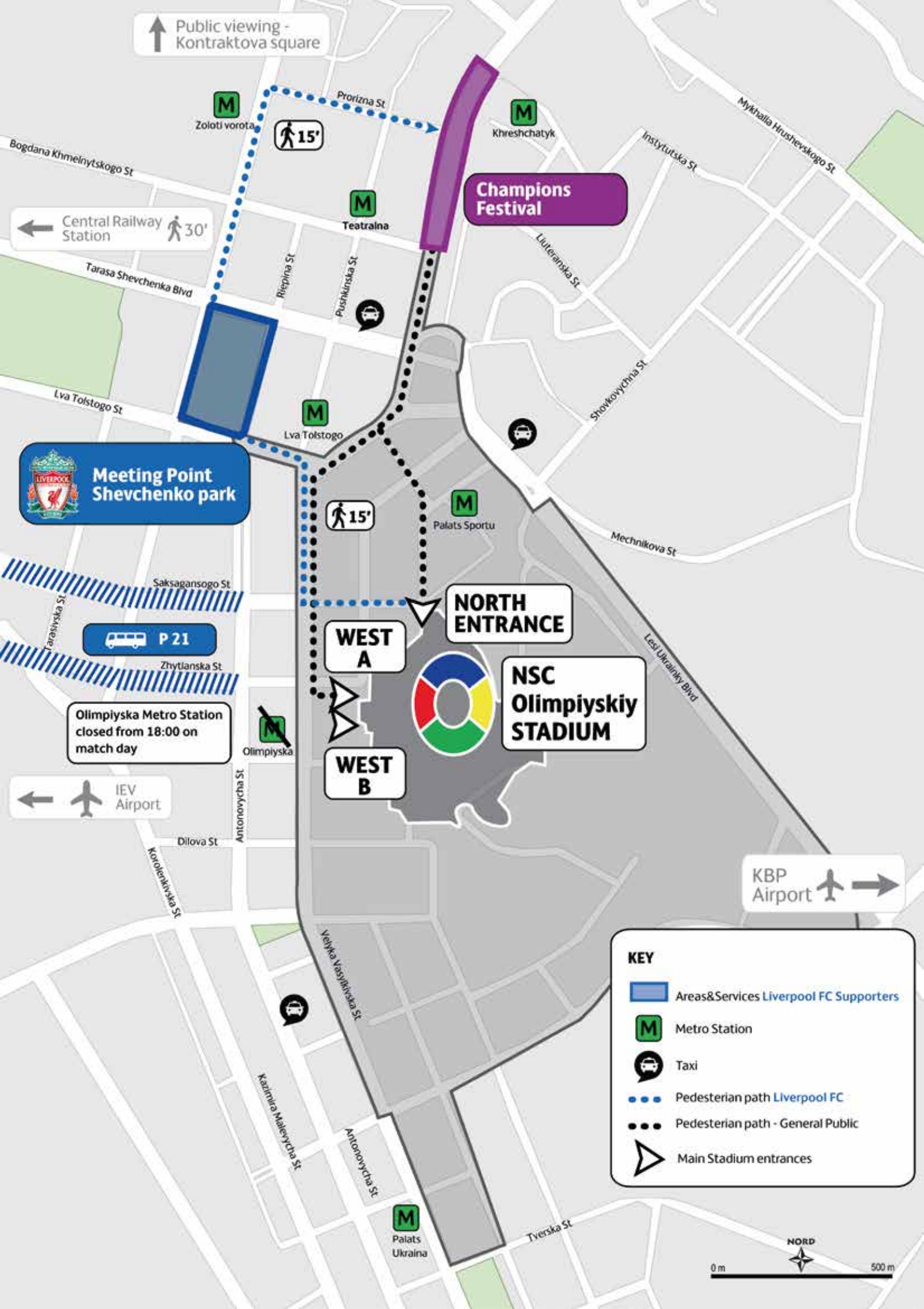
By entering the stadium, you consent to your image and voice being used for photographs, live and delayed broadcasts, and image or sound recordings of the event, both at the time of the event and in the future.

You also undertake to follow the instructions of police officers, firefighters, rescue teams, security personnel, stadium announcers, stewards and volunteers.

Security personnel are authorised by the event organiser to deny entry to anyone who (i) is under the influence of drugs or alcohol, (ii) is carrying weapons or other dangerous materials, or (iii) presents a risk to the security of other visitors or the stadium. Any administrative offences will be dealt with in accordance with local law.

MEETING POINT SHEVCHENKO PARK

Taras Shevchenko Park will host the meeting point for Liverpool FC supporters.

This urban park is in an excellent location, only a 15-minute walk from the stadium and the city's main attractions (including the Champions Festival).

It is also very close to the Golden Gate district, with its many bars and restaurants.

This iconic location is a convenient place for Liverpool supporters to gather – both before going to the stadium and after the game en route back to the airport.

Liverpool supporters landing at Boryspil Airport can take a free shuttle bus to Shevchenko Park from in front of Terminal D (journey time of 45 minutes). All shuttle services will be provided by urban buses, with both seated and standing passengers on board.

All airport shuttle buses for Liverpool fans will depart from this same location after the match, with departure times varying depending on the time of the flight. Buses will leave from 30 different platforms on Volodymyrska St and Taras Shevchenko Blvd, as shown on the map.

Only passengers with a proper boarding pass for their flight will be allowed on the buses, which will depart two hours before the flight's departure time. You should plan to reach your bus platform at least 30 minutes prior to the bus's departure in order to board the bus on time and facilitate departure operations.

Please follow all instructions that you receive from staff at the fan meeting point and at the platforms.

The Shevchenko Park meeting point will provide food and beverage facilities, toilets and flight information throughout the night (until 06.00 the next morning), giving Liverpool fans a good place to wait for their bus to the airport.

BAG DEPOSIT FACILITY

Please ensure that you travel light, as only small items can be taken into the stadium (see stadium information for details). If you need to bring a bigger bag, a bag deposit facility is available near Shevchenko Park, on the way to the stadium.



A WORD ON PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Kyiv has an extensive metro network comprising three different lines, providing good access to NSC Olimpiyskiy and all of the main tourist attractions in the city centre. In addition to the metro, the city also has good bus and trolleybus networks.

The metro will be open late after the match (until 03.00), so fans will have no problems getting to their hotels, even if the match goes to extra time and penalties.

Please note that Olimpiyska metro station (blue line; M2) will close at 18.00 on matchday to help with the management of crowds in the vicinity of the stadium entrances.

Each ticket holder will have free access to the city's public transport on matchday by showing his/her match ticket or public transport voucher. This covers all types of municipal transport, including the funicular that leads to the banks of the river Dnieper near the public viewing area at Poshtova Ploshcha.
