

The Adult Day Center Program For People With Verbal Impairments

Desert Arc has taken an innovative approach in providing mini iPads to assist people who are non-verbal or have limited verbal abilities. Through the introduction of the mini iPads clients who are challenged by limited verbal skills are benefiting by increasing their skills to communicate with family, friends and others in their community.



Desert Arc introduced the Look2Learn, an Alternative and Augmentative Communications software to its program participants which allows individuals to work at their own communicative levels using photographs to express their needs and wants.

The Adult Day Center serves over 100 adults who are eligible for this important mini iPad program. The cost per person is \$411. Though this does seem high it is difficult to put a price tag on an item that provides each person with a "voice." Desert Arc is seeking funding for this innovative program that provides the opportunity for each person to speak. The agency has secured funding for almost half of the units needed.

Culinary Arts are Taught at Desert Arc

The Cafeteria Services Academy provides training for clients in all aspects of the culinary arts. The training includes food preparation, serving and storage. The clients in the program prepare a breakfast, lunch and snack for 300 clients daily. Their training includes passing a food handlers' test and receiving a certificate.



Desert Arc participates in the California Child Adult Food Program through the Department of Education that provides a free breakfast, lunch, and snack to all clients in the Adult Day Center program and the Behavior Management Program. Desert Arc's Cafeteria Services follows the same nutritional guidelines required for this program in preparing and serving food to all clients at Desert Arc. Desert Arc provides a free breakfast, lunch and snack to 29 clients in other programs, as determined by staff as being most in need of assistance. These clients cannot afford to purchase food from Cafeteria Services. The limited availability of funding limits the number of clients who can receive the free breakfast, lunch and snack. Currently, Desert Arc has obtained funding annually from four generous local funding sources. These include the Beneto Family Foundation, the Emergency Food & Shelter Program, and the two cities of Rancho Mirage and Indio. This funding provides for approximately 50% of the food costs for the 29 clients in the program. A contribution envelope is attached if you would like to help provide a nutritious meal for a client who cannot afford to purchase a breakfast (\$1), lunch (\$5), and a snack (\$1).

An Academy Style **Employment Training** Introduced

Pathways to **Employment**

Desert Arc introduced the Pathways to Employment academy concept as a new and innovative approach to provide employment training. The academies assist the clients in becoming as self-sufficient as possible at a relatively low cost that impacts their lives. The program initiates an academy-style training program that better serves the

needs of the clients and local employers.

This was a 4-week hands-on cooking class for clients who have an interest in their health and enjoy creating healthy recipes.


