

ONLY CONGRESS MAY LEGISLATE ACT

STATE ENFORCEMENT OF PRESIDENTIAL EXECUTIVE ORDERS FORBIDDEN

For over 100 years Presidential Executive Orders that have exceeded the authority of the Executive Branch have been issued by both Democrat and Republican Presidents. Many Presidential Executive Orders are not intended to execute laws passed by Congress but are intended to bypass Congress and create the President's own unaccountable "laws". The Constitution for the United States of America prohibits legislation from either the Executive or Judicial Branches of the Federal Government.

Article I, Section 1 of the United States Constitution states:

"All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives."

Therefore, any executive order, memorandum, proclamation, presidential decision document, signing statement or any other "supposed legislation" by any name whatsoever, issued by any President, past, present, or future, that has not been affirmed by a vote of the Congress of the United States and signed into law as prescribed by the Constitution for the United States, is advisory only and has no force or effect in the state of _____.

Any federal regulation, rule, or memorandum promulgated as a result of that executive order is _____ repugnant to the Constitution for the United States and the Constitution of _____(state) and shall be declared invalid in this state and all subdivisions of this state. Such regulations, rules, or memoranda shall be considered null and void, and no agency or political subdivision of this state shall take any action or utilize any resources to give effect to such rules, regulations, or memoranda.

Whoever, under provision of any law, statute, ordinance, regulation, or custom, willfully subjects any person in _____(state) to the deprivation of any rights, privileges, or immunities secured or protected by the Constitution for the United States or laws of _____(state) shall be fined under this title or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both; and if bodily injury results from the acts committed in violation of this section or if such acts include the use, attempted use, or threatened use of a dangerous weapon, explosives, or fire, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than ten years, or both; and if death results from the acts committed in violation of this section or if such acts include kidnapping or an attempt to kidnap, aggravated sexual abuse, or an attempt to commit aggravated sexual abuse, or an attempt to kill, shall be fined under this title, or imprisoned for any term of years or for life, or both, or may be sentenced to death.

All cases arising under the terms of this statute shall be tried in the courts of _____(state).

It shall be the duty of the state legislature to adopt and enact any and all measures as might be necessary to prevent the enforcement of such executive orders, regulations, rules, or memoranda.

This act shall take effect upon passage by the legislature and being signed by the governor.
