166 GERTRUDE ST, FITZROY

ANCHORAGE APARTMENTS, HAMPTON

- "Comprising a gym, 6 levels of apartments and 3 basement levels of automated carpark accessed via a car lift, this project is set to become an exemplar of inner city urban re-development at Hampton, one of Melbourne's designated high density activity centres.
 The building form steps away from its lower level podiums to create a narrower sculpted upper form oriented to maximize bay views. A communal terrace occupies part of the podium level."
- Painting and rendering of interior and exterior. All internals including basement (line marking, floor sealer), apartments, common areas.
- External areas include soffits, external walls with anti-graffiti on ground level, timber claddings, and canopy structural steel, with rendering.




PALAIS THEATRE, ST KILDA

MULLUM MULLUM STADIUM

GGC are currently in the process of completing the painting works at Mullum Mullum Stadium, Springvale Road, Donvale.

Mullum Mullum Stadium is 6,000m2 of sustainable features, and once in operation, it will boast some impressive figures.

"IT IS ESTIMATED THAT THE STADIUM WILL CATER FOR ABOUT 100,000 USERS ANNUALLY."

- 1,330 solar panels will help power the stadium. 450kW system will provide cumulative savings of \$2.2 million over the 25 year life cycle.
- The facility will provide almost 18 million kilograms of CO2 savings out of the atmosphere over the system's life. This also equates to 3,250 vehicles off our roads or powering 3,125 homes.
