



## MOORPARK HIGH SCHOOL BATTLE OF THE BANDS 2016

### GENERAL TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

#### WHEN

Saturday, November 12, 2016: gates open at 8:30 a.m.

#### WHERE

Moorpark High School, 4500 Tierra Rejada Road, Moorpark, California, 93021. From the 101 Fwy. or 118 Fwy., take the 23 Freeway into Moorpark and exit Tierra Rejada Road. Head west on Tierra Rejada Rd. and turn right on Country Wood Drive.

#### ADMISSION

Spectator admission may be purchased at any of the three admission booths for \$12 adults, \$9 students/seniors, and children 5 years and under are free. Programs are \$5. The Battle of the Bands is a fundraiser for the Moorpark High School Instrumental Music Program, so all proceeds will go to maintain our music program.

#### PARKING

Spectators should park in the main spectator parking lots at Arroyo Vista Community Park and conveniently enter the stadium at the stadium field-level admission booth (also the Pit Entrance). Parking is also available behind the stores in the parking lot across the street from Moorpark High School, and on adjacent side streets. For vehicles with valid handicapped placards, reserved handicapped parking is available at the top of the stadium, accessed via the Mountain Trail Entrance Gate. Because of limited parking space, there is **no spectator parking on campus. Please note that the gates to the parking area in front of the Arroyo Vista Community Center will be locked by the city at 10 PM. Parking beyond the Arroyo Vista Community Center – towards the soccer fields - will be locked by dusk!**

#### SEATING

All spectators will view the tournament from the HOME-SIDE of the stadium. There will be limited seating on the home side for bands.

#### RESTROOMS

There are 3 built-in and several portable toilets strategically placed around the campus.

#### FIRST AID In an emergency, dial 911

The First Aid station, run by "Event Medical Standbys," is located between the "I" building and the Auxiliary Gym, behind the home-side seating area. There is emergency medical service on standby, and water and bandages available at First Aid. Please contact your band guide, or any event staff, to relay a request for help. #### FOUL WEATHER
