Dear Parent/Guardian,

Thank you for your help and support in making both of the Year 6 Transition days a real success. It has also been really positive to meet a number of you through the drop in clinics we have been running on a Monday afternoon. More information about further drop in clinics during September/October will be sent out when the students return to school on Tuesday 4 September.

I also wanted to draw your attention to a few key dates below and some information that will hopefully make the transition in September a bit easier:

Monday 3 September is a school inset day. The first full day at school is Tuesday 4 September. Students will need to be on the tennis courts by 8:40am where their tutor and transition prefects will be waiting for them.
