## Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order by OSTA president, Jamie Miller. A big thank you was given to the Tim and the East Holmes Kitchen Crew for keeping us well fed.

With no old business to discuss, Jamie, on behalf of the officers, brought up for discussion the Family Cap for shooting. When the Shooter's Fees were adjusted a couple years ago, no adjustment was made to the family cap. As it stands now, for those that fall under the Family Cap, members and non-members pay the same. Also even though individual Shooter's Fees are raised for the State Shoot (unlimited shooting), there is no increase in the Family Cap amount. The Officers propose keeping the Family Cap for MEMBERS at \$20.00 for regular shoots and raising it to \$25.00 for the State Shoot. They also propose raising the Family Cap for NON-MEMBERS to \$25.00 for regular shoots and \$30.00 for the State Shoot. Discussion ensued with the general consensus being to bring this to a vote. The membership will vote on this at the State Shoot. Should the increase be approved, it will be in effect for the 2008 season.

Hoot Gibson reminded to everyone to bring items for the AUCTION at the State Shoot. All proceeds will benefit the Kid's Bow program. The Auction will be held on Saturday evening at the State Shoot. All items to be auctioned need to be given to Hoot Gibson or one of the officers. Ryan Brewer offered his Grampa for auction. While we appreciate Ryan's desire to contribute to the auction, we feel that his Grampa is too valuable to be auctioned and is best staying exactly where he is...keeping Ryan et al in line. It was also brought up how everyone enjoyed making the arrows at Blackhoof and that there is interest in helping make the bows. Suggestion was made to try to get together over the cold months and work on these things so that we can start next year in good shape. Greg Scott offered his workshop as a place to do this. Jamie will get with Greg and with Paul to work out the details and will let us know when they get it set up.

Brian Melick announced that we will be initiating a "challenge" stake. This stake will be set in a way to make the shot ***very challenging***. It will be non-competition in the sense that no pin award will be given. The reward for winning this category will be "bragging rights" and your name in the Newsletter. We will have the initiation of the competition at the State Shoot.

Hoot Gibson read a Thank You to OSTA from Linda Denny. Linda's dad passed away July 14th. A copy is included in this newsletter.

A request has been made to get shirts in a lighter color as the dark green can be so hot. The officers will discuss this further and choose a lighter color and as needed, order some additional shirts.

Meeting was adjourned.
