As the AAU TKD Gulf District Chairman, I am pleased to announce the 2016 Gulf District AAU TKD National Qualifier. As in the many past years it will be held at Butler Sports Complex Field House, 13755 South Main Houston TX, 77035 on Saturday, May 7th, 2016.

The AAU TKD Nationals will be held July 4th-9th, 2016 in Ft. Lauderdale, Florida at the Broward County Convention Center. Competitors who place in the top 8 of their qualifying events qualify for the AAU TKD Nationals.

This year I am excited to offer many new exciting events to the championship. Please make sure that you read all of the pages enclosed in this information packet. **Notice the staging times listed on the information sheet of the packet. They are much different than past years.**

The main qualifying events are: Olympic Sparring, Point Sparring, Traditional Forms, and Special Needs. In addition to these, we are offering exciting, challenging, non-qualifying, energizing events for those who may want to test their skills with other specialties! It will also help prepare those students that may want to compete at the AAU JR Olympic Games being held here in Houston this summer July 28th-30th at the George R. Brown Convention Center. TKD is just one of 30 sports being offered within the AAU. The AAU is the original true JR Olympics.

The new non-qualifying events this year are: Team Point Sparring, Team Forms, Creative or Traditional Weapons Forms, Board Breaking, that will entail different challenging and exciting sub events for you to try individually or as a team. All of the criteria for each event is detailed inside the attached packet.

For those that are not up to date on the AAU JR Olympic Games, TKD does not have any sparring in the games. It has evolved into a Hanmadang with many different exciting and challenging events. The past two years have seen an exciting exceptional growth with this. Make sure to check out all the different events listed on the AAU TKD website.

Black belts ages 10-32 (team trial ages) will be using the KP&P E Hogu. You must supply your own footgear. It can be purchased at www.mykick.com.

As in past years, the registration is only online, being conducted by the AAU headquarters in Orlando, Florida. Please have your 2016 AAU membership number ready before you register.

When you are ready to register, go to www.aautaekwondo.org and click on the "Online Registration" in the quick links section on the left. Then click on Gulf Online Registration. This will get you to the proper information to register.

We as the Gulf AAU are committed to the growth of TKD in our community and feel that we can offer the best quality local TKD event around. Each ring will be centered by our top Referees with the highest level of experience from around the U.S. and Houston area. Our Olympic style coaches are the most educated and have produced some of the most notable athletes to participate on an international level. Medals will be awarded to the top four (4) competitors in each division completed for NON qualifying events.

A TEAM CUP will be awarded to the first place Point Sparring Team and Team Forms in addition to the individual gold medals. 1st place Black Belt Adult power board breaking and high flying side kick will receive

a 5 foot trophy with a nameplate that says "AAU TKD Gulf District Foot Sword Champion".

The tournament Committee reserves the right to further divide or combine divisions depending on the number of competitors registered to compete in each event.

Point Sparring

- Rules according to the 2016 AAU Taekwondo Point Sparring Competition Rules
- Single elimination bracket
- National Qualifying Event

Team Point Sparring

- 4 Members: Black Belts ONLY, Junior team and/or Adult team, males with males and females with females
- 2 Rounds, 2 minutes each fight
- Single elimination bracket
- 1st round coin toss the blue team will display their first four fighters, red team places theirs against each one.
- Round 1, each of the selected fighters fight 2 minutes each
- (TAG TEAM) Round 2 the coach from each side can switch out the fighter one time during each 2-minute round
- 1st place team award is a Team Championship Cup in addition to a gold medal for the individuals
- This event does not qualify you for the AAU Nationals

Special Needs Point Sparring

- Rules according to the 2016 AAU Special Needs Taekwondo Point Sparring Competition Rules
- Single elimination bracket
- National Qualifying Event

Olympic Sparring

- Rules according to the 2016 AAU Taekwondo Olympic Sparring Competition Rules
- Black Belts divisions ages 10-32 will use the electronic HOGU KP&P
- Single elimination bracket
- Black Belts ages 10-32 have to supply their own KP&P foot gear, which can be purchased at or www.dynamicsworld.com or www.mykick.com
- National Qualifying Event

Individual Traditional Forms

- Recognized and approved forms are specified in the 2016 AAU Taekwondo Handbook
- Brazilian Repechagebrackets
- Judging criteria includes Beauty, Grace, Rhythm, Focus, Power & Technique
- National Qualifying Event

Weapons Forms

- Both Traditional and Creative weapons forms will be permitted
- No live blades will be allowed
- Single elimination bracket
- Weapons are subject to inspection by the Chief Referee and may be prohibited if deemed unsafe
- Judging criteria includes Beauty, Grace, Rhythm, Focus, Power, Technique & Creativity
- This event does not qualify you for the AAU Nationals

Team Forms

- 3 Members: Black Belts ONLY, Juniors or Adult team, males and females can be mixed together
- Recognized and approved forms are specified in the 2016 AAU Taekwondo Handbook
- Forms may not be modified
- Single elimination bracket
- Judging criteria includes Beauty, Grace, Rhythm, Focus, Power, Technique & how well team performs as a unit
- 1st place team award is a Team Championship Cup in addition to a gold medal for the individuals
- This event does not qualify you for the AAU Nationals

Board Breaking* (see next page on Supplemental Board Breaking Information)

SPECIAL NOTES: For AAU Taekwondo Competitions: Novice Division consist of White, Orange and Yellow belts. Intermediate Divisions consist of Green, Purple and Blue. Advanced Divisions consist of both Red and Brown Belts. Black Belt Divisions are meant to include Junior Black as well. If your school or club uses any other belt ranking order or system, your athlete should conform to the above mentioned criteria. Also Poom Belts (half red and half black) should be worn by JUNIOR Black Belts ages 15 and younger ONLY!

SUPPLEMENTAL BOARD BREAKING INFORMATION

Competitors use the following board sizes for each board breaking event:

- 8 & under 12 x 6 x ½ inch pine
- 9-11 year olds 12 x 7 x 1 inch pine
- 12 & up 12 x 9 x 1 inch pine
- No thinner/shaved boards may be used for breaking competition

BREAKING: Team Speed Board Breaking * Creative Breaking * Power Foot Breaking * High Flying Side Kick
Only the boards supplied by the tournament host will be allowed, which include: boards purchased online during registration, and extra boards purchased with CASH at the event.

Creative Board Breaking

- Single elimination bracketed forms
- Up to 3 stations per competitor with a maximum of 3 attempts per station
- NO: spacers, forehead breaking, open flames, bladed props, jumping/flying over people
- Athlete technique will be judged based on the following criteria:
 - * Technique, focus, balance, power and creativity
 - * A break performed on the 1st try is superior to a break completed on the 2nd try
 - * A 2 board break is superior to a 1 board break, a 3 board break is superior to a 2 board break
 - * A break supported on 1 end (speed break) is superior to a break supported on both ends

Power Foot Breaking

- Single elimination bracketed forms
- Certain age divisions could be broken into lightweight and heavyweight
- 1 station per competitor, a board holding machine that can hold up to 10 boards is available for adults
- Acceptable techniques include any kicking technique executed using a part of the foot below the ankle
- NO STOMP!
- No spacers will be allowed
- Maximum of 3 attempts allowed
- Judging criteria is based on the number of boards broken to determine the winner. The competitor who breaks the most (or in the event of a tie, has the highest percentage broken) is the winner.
 - *Tie Example: Competitor "A" broke at 100%, competitor "B" broke at 83%. Competitor "A" is the winner. If more than one competitor has the same percentage broken after their initial break, there will be a break off to determine the winner.
- Black Belt Adult 1st place will receive a 5 foot trophy with a nameplate that says "AAU TKD Gulf District Foot Sword Champion."

Team Speed Board Breaking

- Single elimination bracketed forms
- 6 person teams of any age, gender, rank
- 12 boards per team
- 1st round side kick, 2nd time through hammer fist
- 1 board per strike
- Have your wood stacked according to size for the ages rotating through your line
- Remember to allow for one extra volunteer to quickly hand the wood to the holder(s)
- Fastest team to break all 12 boards wins

High Flying Side Kick – ADULT BLACK BELTS ONLY AGE 15 and UP

- Single 1" board
- Each competitor will start with the same minimum board height. Every competitor that breaks within their maximum of 3 attempts will move on to the next round, in which the board height will be raised.
- This will continue for however many rounds until only one competitor is left standing.
- Black Belt Adult 1st place will receive a 5 foot trophy with a nameplate that says "AAU TKD Gulf District Foot Sword Champion."
