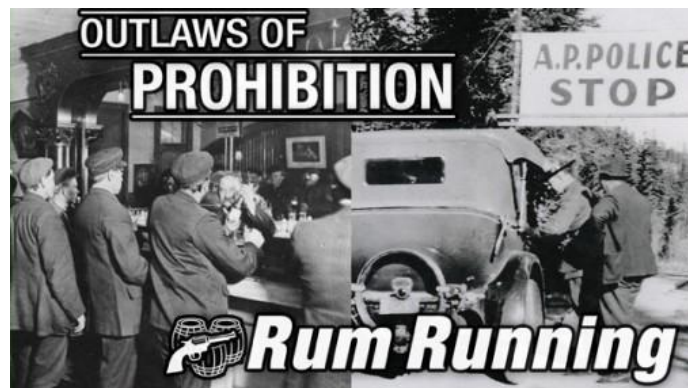

## HOW TO USE THIS PASSPORT

1. Download the Coordinates for the following Caches on Geocaching.com or enter them manually from this Passport.
2. Fill the Passport. It is recommended you travel from the West to the East.
3. Once stamped, bring passport back to the Museum. Collect your prize by closing time on Monday, August 1, 2016.
4. Geocaching.com rules apply to all the caches. Trading of items and travel bugs are allowed. Please remember to use Stealth in the appropriate locations.
5. **PLEASE DO NOT REMOVE THE STAMPS! Those are not trade-able.**

### **CNP Prohibition 16-1** **N49 37.986 W114 36.804**

This is a site with dual history. This was a route over Phillips Pass that was used by bootleggers known as the Rumrunner Route. Also this is the area where the NWMP Detachment was located at Crowsnest Lake in 1897 when the Crowsnest Rail Line was built through the community.

GEOCACHE STAMP HERE:

### **CNP Prohibition 16-2** **N49 37.904 W114 35.958**

This is the site of the Sentinel Train robbery where Picariello was rumoured to be on the train. This crime led to the Shoot Out at the Bellevue Cafe.

### **CNP Prohibition 16-3** **N49 37.952 W114 32.472**

Alberta Provincial Police Stop

GEOCACHE STAMP HERE:

### **CNP Prohibition 16-4** **N49 38.036 W114 30.222**

Coleman Hotel. 7652-17<sup>th</sup> Ave) This is the site where Constable Lawson fired at Steve Picariello when he refused to stop.

GEOCACHER STAMP HERE:

### **CNP Prohibition 16-5** **WAYPOINT ONLY** **N49 38.093 W114 30.102**

A multiple historic site. 7709-18<sup>th</sup> Ave was originally known as the APP Building and is where Constable Lawson was shot by either Picariello or Losandro. The Coleman Seniors Centre (7801-18<sup>th</sup> Ave) was the Mine Union Hospital where Constable Lawson was taken and pronounced dead.

NOTE: The Town of Coleman Jail Cells can be seen in the Museum Yard.

What color is the building?

### **CNP Prohibition 16-6** **WAYPOINT ONLY** **N49 38.045 W114 30.108**

A Dual Historic Site. The Post Office is where the Opera House used to stand and where Picariello and Losandro's Preliminary Hearing was held. The Grand Theatre (7755-17<sup>th</sup> Ave) was where Margaret Lawson saw Picariello and Losandro drive to the APP Building.

What is west of the Post Office?

### **CNP Prohibition 16-7** **N49 36.467 W114 26.322**

Dual Historic Site: Alberta Hotel (12849-20<sup>th</sup> Ave): This was Picariello's Hotel where the chase of Steve Picariello started. Tunnels were excavated under the Hotel to hide alcohol. Rosse Building (13013 -20<sup>th</sup> Ave) Michael Rosse owned a liquor store and was alleged to be involved as a bootlegger.

GEOCACHE STAMP HERE:

### **CNP Prohibition 16-8** **N49 36.452 W114 26.018**

RNWMP Police Barracks (13307 -20<sup>th</sup> Ave) Is now home to Grace Anglican United Church.

Describe Cache Container:

### **CNP Prohibition 16-9** **WAYPOINT ONLY** **N49 36.432 W114 25.888**

Originally was the RCMP Barracks – Blairmore Courthouse and Jail.

### **CNP Prohibition 16-10** **N49 36.332 W114 24.948**

Old Frank NWMP/RNWP site. There was also a Sanatorium here at one time.
