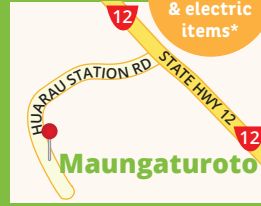
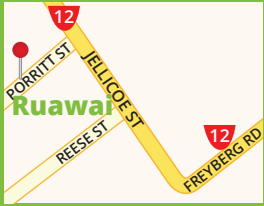

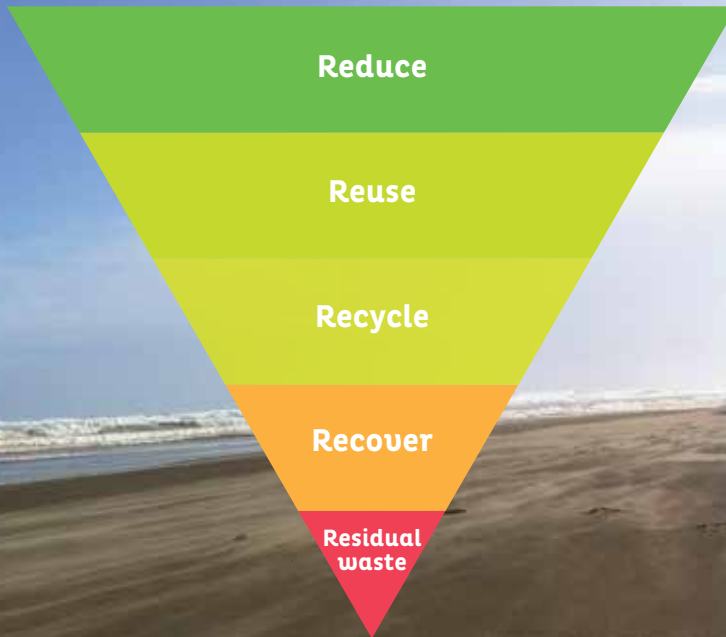

- Buy in bulk to save money and reduce packaging
- Feed suitable food scraps to chooks or dog
- Choose long lasting items instead of disposable ones
- Shop local growers markets
- Use reusable bags
- Slow down and dine in, or BYO coffee cup
- Start a worm farm or compost to keep green waste out of landfill
- Use reusable drink bottles
- Take your recycling to one of our transfer stations
- Choose products with recyclable, reusable or biodegradable packaging
- Setup a recycling bin at your school, marae, sports club or church
- Repair or repurpose
- Buy second hand
- Say **No thanks** to plastic bags
- Say **No thanks** to disposable plastics
