### Accounting Careers Awareness Program

The Greater Orlando Chapter of the National Association of Black Accountants will host its 8<sup>th</sup> annual Accounting Careers Awareness Program at the University of Central Florida, July 14-19, 2019. The Accounting Careers Awareness Program (ACAP) is the signature pipeline program of the National Association of Black Accountants (NABA). The primary objective of ACAP is to increase the understanding of accounting and business career opportunities among high school students from underrepresented ethnic groups.

Florida minority high school students (rising juniors or seniors) with a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.8 are encouraged to apply. This one week residency program provides the opportunity for student participants to live on a college campus, interact with university professors, administrators, and local companies, and engage in personal and professional development seminars. The students must also prepare a group presentation to showcase what they have learned throughout the week and there is a closing luncheon to celebrate completion of the program. Speakers for the daily seminars are from local organizations and members of the Greater Orlando community, with many being a part of the NABA professional chapter.



Program participation is limited to 20 students, and each student must be present for the entire length of the program (Sunday evening through Friday afternoon). There is also a mandatory orientation session, which is typically held the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday in May, and a \$25 registration fee.
