



The Kativik Environmental Quality Commission requires that Innalik complies with the following 13 conditions:

1. Construction must be undertaken within 5 years of authorization date (23 August 2019): by 2024

Social impacts:

2. Create a follow-up and cooperation committee
3. Develop a program to monitor social impacts of the facility during construction and operations
4. Take steps to maximize local and regional hiring and training
5. Develop a reinvestment plan and report on socioeconomic development and hiring plans

To protect Inukjuak's drinking water, before working in water:

6. Share details, including location, of the temporary drinking water intake
7. All material for the temporary water intake must be ready, and be inspected and maintained regularly
8. Prepare and submit an emergency action plan; implement preventive measures at construction site

Other environmental measures:

9. During construction, monitor drinking water and communicate the results
10. Track mercury levels in fish through a monitoring program and communicate the results

Before the end of construction, submit the planned measures to:

11. Support the landing protocol, which aims at integrating positively the project within the community
12. Restore and clean-up any area impacted by the project
13. Submit compensation plans for loss of fish habitat and wetland; organize monitoring
