# My Irish Wish List Video Competition

## 1. Overview

The Embassy of Ireland, Republic of Korea, and The Irish Association of Korea are pleased to announce the launch of the 2019 “My Irish Wish List’ video Competition for university students in Korea.

This competition allows contestants to compete for an opportunity to experience Ireland from an educational, cultural, and academic perspective. It also seeks to raise awareness about Ireland and the opportunities through Education and Travel that Ireland can offer Korean students.

Participants are invited to make a fun, creative 3 minute long video on the theme “*My Irish Wish List*”. The entrants are free to share their experiences, impressions and hopes within the context of the topic and are encouraged to film on location in Korea.

First prize will include two weeks of study in the Emerald Cultural Institute ([www.eci.ie](http://www.eci.ie)), including accommodation, return flights from Korea to Dublin, and spending money. Second prize will receive return flights from Korea to Dublin. The final runner up will receive a book voucher and a gift voucher for Gwatop, a private language tutor matching platform that allows you to take private English lessons.

## 2. Topic

Participants are invited to submit a fun, creative 3 minutes video. The video must not be longer than 3 minutes and must include at least 90 seconds in spoken English.

### **3. Rules**

- The competition is open to enrolled, full time, under-graduate Korean students.
- The competition is NOT open to exchange students or students who use English as their first language/mother tongue.
- Submissions must not be longer than 3 minutes and must include at least 90 seconds in spoken English.
- All work must be original work and must NOT have received an award from another contest.
- All submissions should respect copyright laws – entrants must ensure that they have permission to use any music, video, or animation that appears in their video.
- The organizers will not be held responsible for any unauthorized inclusion of any content or materials within or relating to the submitted video.
- No commercial, abusive or offensive content is permitted.
- Prize winners must confirm their travel details by 30<sup>th</sup> September 2019

### **4. Guidelines**

- First, make a video of no longer than 3 minutes. (Videos can be made using phones, digital camera or any digital device)
- Second, upload on [www.youtube.com](http://www.youtube.com)
