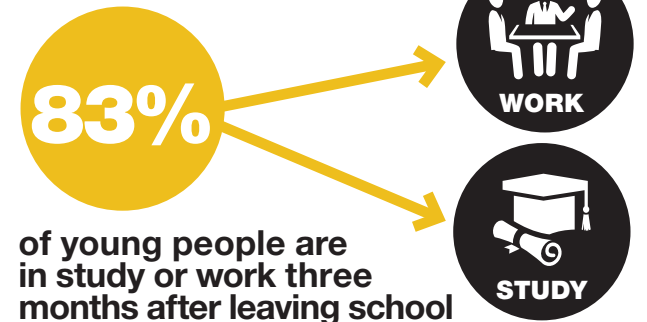

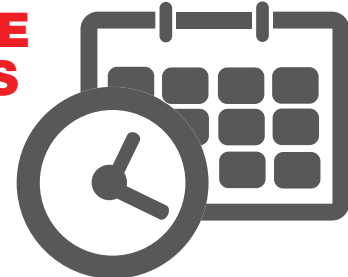

SKILLS THAT CAN BE USED ACROSS MANY JOBS: LITERACY/NUMERACY, SCIENCE, DIGITAL LITERACY, FINANCIAL SKILLS, PROJECT MANAGEMENT, WORKING WITH OTHERS, CREATIVITY, PROBLEM SOLVING, CULTURAL/CIVIC LITERACY.

A review of 4.2 million job ads across Australia shows that these skills are: on the rise, required in many jobs/occupations and higher paid³.

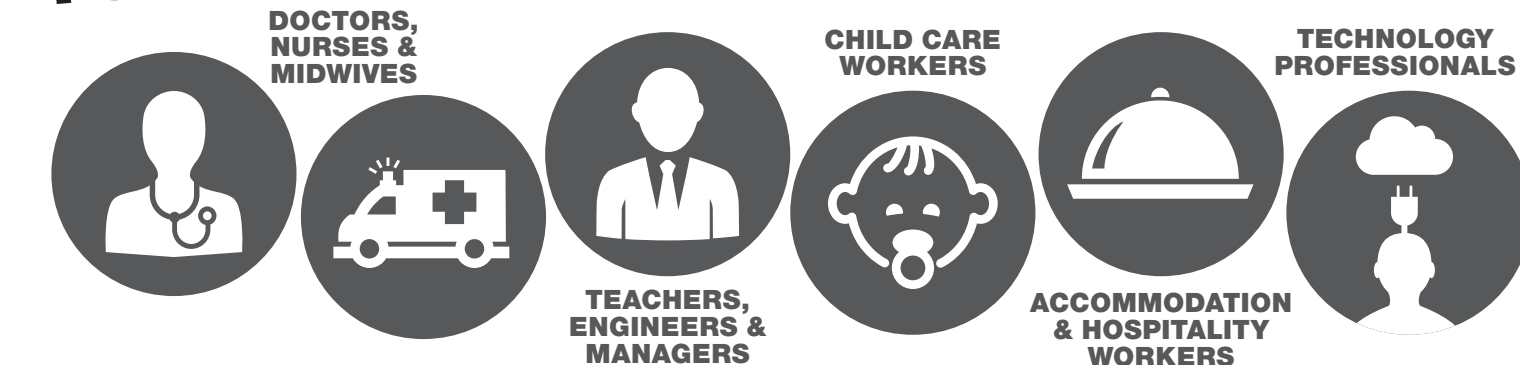
