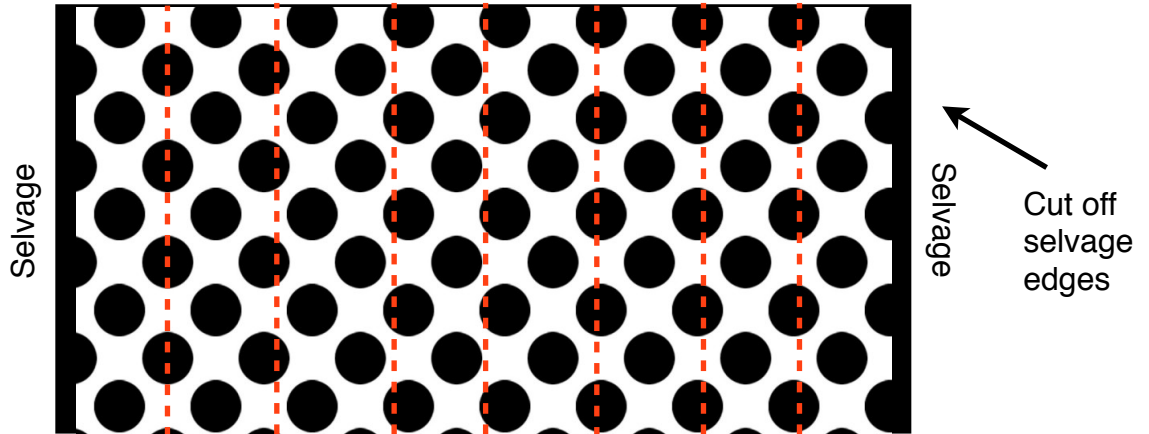


Strip Quilt Directions

These directions make a
Double size Quilt using (5) one yard cuts of fabric.
77" x 90"

Step: 1 Cut each one yard into (8) 5 1/4" strips. If making the crib size cut each fat quarter into (4) 5 1/4 " strips.

Use a
standard
quilting 1/4"
seam
allowance



Step: 2 Randomly sew all of the strips together, short end to short end, into a very long strip. Be careful to sew all directional fabric so they are going the same direction.



Step: 3

Cut the long strip into 90" strips. Then sew those strips together on the long sides.
*** Use the chart if you are making a different size.**

Step: 4

Continue **randomly** sewing the 90" strips together until your quilt top is complete.

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Follow the chart below to make the
Strip Quilt in a variety of sizes.

Crib Quilt 38" x 52"

You will need (6) Fat Quarters
In Step 3 cut long strip into 52" strips

Twin Quilt 65" x 83"

You will need (5) - 3/4 yards
In Step 3 cut long strip into - 83" strips

Queen Quilt 85" x 96"

You will need (6) - 1 yards
In Step 3 cut long strip into - 96" strips

King Quilt 104" x 98"

You will need (6) - 1 1/4 yards
In Step 3 cut long strip into - 98" strips
