

HALL OF FAME REINING AUSTRALIA

The Standard of Excellence achieved by an individual Person or Horse in any of the criteria is at a level set by Reining Australia Hall of Fame and the Board of Directors or approved Committee. To be considered by Reining Australia Hall of Fame a person/horse must meet the following selection criteria:

Selection Criteria for Nomination of a Person

- Competitors: must have earnings over \$200,000 in prize money, or have won 3 x Open National Futurity Championships.
- Non Pro's: must have earnings over \$50,000 in prize money, or have won 3 x Non Pro National Open, NP/Futurity Championships.
- Breeders: must have bred and owned 3 separate progeny with combined earnings of over \$100,000, or have won 5 x National/Open/Non Pro Futurity/Derby Championships with 3 separate progeny (minimum \$25000 earnings per horse).
- Owners: must own 3 separate progeny with combined earnings of over \$50,000, or owned 3 x National/Open/Non Pro Futurity/Derby Champions with 3 separate horses (minimum \$5000 earnings per horse).
- Members: This is a special category for members of Reining Australia that the Board has acknowledged as a person who has worked tirelessly to support and promote the sport of Reining in Australia or someone who the Board feels deserves inducting into the Hall of Fame.

Selection Criteria for Nomination of a Horse

- Stallions: Must have 5 or more progeny with combined earnings of over \$100,000 in prize money or have sired 5 separate progeny, which have won a National/Open/Non Pro Futurity/Derby Championships.
- Mares: Must have produced 3 or more progeny with combined earnings of over \$30,000 in prize money or have produced 3 separate progeny, which have won a National/Open/Non Pro Futurity/Derby Championships (minimum \$5000 earnings per horse).
- Performance Horses: Must have earnings of over \$30,000 in prize money or have won 3 x National Championships Futurity/Derby/Open/Open Non Pro, or promoted Reining in Australia to the highest standard.
- Horse: This is a special category for horses that do not meet the criteria in any other category but have promoted Reining in Australia. This category is for Stallions, Mares and Performance horses that have had a great impact on the Reining industry in Australia.



HALL OF FAME REINING AUSTRALIA

Upon meeting the criteria set out by Reining Australia, the nomination must fill out the official form and return it to the Reining Australia Secretary.

All inductees for the Hall of Fame must have the nomination advertised in the Reining Australia Slider and on the Website

If 30 working days from the date of advertising no objections are received, the nomination can advance.

Any person who objects to the nominee being inducted into the Reining Australia Hall of Fame must put their objections in writing to the Board within 30 working days.

It will then be reviewed by the Board and appropriate action taken following the investigation of the objection.

It will then be discussed and with the approval of the Board of Reining Australia, awarded at a ceremony to be held at the Reining Australia Futurity Show.

If fraudulent or misleading information is presented or the inductee brings Reining Australia into disrepute, the inductee could be viewed by the Board of Reining Australia as unworthy of such an honour and disciplinary action may be taken.

Decisions of the Board of Reining Australia will be final.
