



Reining Australia Youth – Stallions/Colt Policy

Reining Australia has adopted a policy that all Youth are not permitted to handle, ride or exhibit colts or stallions at any Reining Australia or NRHA events. Also geldings who have just been gelded under 30 days.

1. Youth Riding /Handling Stallions

Youth are not permitted to handle, ride or exhibit colts or stallions at any, NRHA or RA approved event, for example clinics and shows. Exceptions for Handling Stallions ONLY at NRHA, RA Approved Shows would only be considered by written Applications to the Reining Australia Board.

The policy states...

All youth 18 years and under participating in any Reining Australia, NRHA events for example shows and clinics are not permitted to handle, ride or exhibit colts or stallions anywhere on the event grounds.

The show committee or Clinician must immediately prohibit any youth violating this rule at any time; all violations of this rule must be reported to the Reining Australia disciplinary committee for review within 15 days of the event.

Criteria for Applications of exception:

- Youth must be of the age of 16 years or older.
- A comprehensive Safety Risk assessment must be provided with the written application.
- All written applications must be from an adult and must be current members of RA with an administrative fee of \$25 paid with the application.
