
#### **Safer Busy Streets** |


# Where should we [temporarily] expand sidewalks and corners <u>first</u>?



#### Safer Busy Streets | Leading with Equity & Demand

### Within East Portland Pedestrian Districts:

- 1. <u>Narrow curb-tight sidewalks</u> on arterials/collectors
- Adjacent to ROW that can be quickly claimed for temporary space for walking
- Priority on <u>mixed-use locations</u> within Ped Districts over singlefamily streets
























#### **Outreach & Engagement**








#### **Criteria for Round 1:**


- Existing neighborhood greenway
- Greenways without sidewalks
- Greenways nearby or intersecting with multifamily housing
- Greenways more than ¼ mile from parks and open space
- Greenways with too much auto traffic to safely encourage physical distancing.


