- School involves parents and makes them aware of what the children are doing and how they can help the children to improve


- Good quality of school life and inclusive atmosphere

We are keen to work on and develop any concerns or suggestions that parents may have. Shown below are areas of concerns and suggestions (**where more than 3 parents made similar comments**) and our response to these.

Concerns/Suggestions	What we have done/will do
Information regarding children's progress and ability.	We share information regarding children's levels and progress at parents evening and on the annual report. We introduced the interim report last year to give additional information mid way through the year. All year groups share with parents the topic and work being covered each term. Reception parents will be invited to a phonics session to explain the expectations within this area. If you do not feel you have enough information about your child's levels and progress please ask your child's teacher who will arrange a time to speak to you about this.
Homework	A few parents were concerned that there was too much homework and some that there was not enough. It will always be difficult to keep all parents happy. We try and ensure that homework is purposeful, effective and achievable.
Parking	We fully agree that this continues to be a problem. We do try and monitor this as often as we can but we need parents to take responsibility and park legally and safely around school. If you are aware of parents parking irresponsibly, please let the school know and we will challenge the individuals concerned. We will put the cones out before and after school on both entrances to the school.
Holidays	No holidays will be authorised in term time. From September 2013 the Government changed the regulations regarding holidays in term time (Education Pupil Registration Regulations 2013.) The amendments made clear that head teachers MAY NOT grant any leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances.
Communication	We send out a monthly newsletter which is always added to the website. We are moving to a new text system shortly and have promoted with parents our smartphone app and twitter account. We are hoping to get the children involved in this so that each year group will be able to tweet and post information.

We appreciate all of your views about the school and hope that we can continue to build upon the way in which parents have their say in school life. Please remember that if you have any concerns or good ideas about how we can improve our school we would like to hear from you.
