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Dear Parents,

We would like to welcome you all to Year 1. You will be glad to know that all the children have settled so well into their new setting. We look forward to making your child's learning fun and enjoyable and aim to provide you with support to help your child throughout the year.

### **Autumn Topic**

Our topic for the first half term is 'Memories'. We will be learning lots about old and new toys and houses. As we encourage children to continue their learning at home, it would be greatly appreciated if you could help your child research their topic. This can be done by either sharing information about old toys that you might own or by supporting them on the internet or reading books. The children have already thoroughly enjoyed their visit to Brampton museum where they enjoyed finding out about and making old toys.

For the second half term we will be celebrating 'Christmas through the times'. The children will be both excited and fascinated to learn about the traditions linked to Christmas and why they became customary! More information about this topic will be available after the half term break.

### **Reading Folder**

Children are asked to bring their reading book and diary into school everyday. Your child will be read with once a week and will bring home a new reading book each week. They will also bring home spellings and sounds to learn. The spellings will be put into the planner each week and sound mats and correct letter formation can be found in their homework books. It is very important that you listen to your child read at home each day and practice spellings. The diary **MUST** be signed each week to show that you have read with your child. Please use the sound mats in their homework books to practise phonic sounds which will help improve your child's reading.

### **Homework**

Children will bring homework home every Friday and must be returned by the following Thursday. Please support your child with this but encourage them to complete it by themselves. If they struggled and needed lots of support then please make a note of this in the diary. **PE Kits**

PE days are Monday and Friday. Please ensure that your child has a full PE kit in school everyday and that it is clearly marked with the child's name. In addition, on PE lesson days please ensure that all jewellery is removed. All earrings must be removed on PE days as staff are not permitted to remove earrings.

### **Planners**

In addition to you signing each week to say you have read with your child, pages 4, 6 and 7 of the planners must be signed **immediately** so that your child is able to access the internet in school.
