Next steps following feedback from our parent questionnaires:

Dojo reward system:

- Comments from parents/carers have been communicated back with staff at school and consistency will be ensured across the use of the system and distribution of dojos.
- We have contacted the 'Dojo' company and are exploring how we can have a running total of dojos for each pupil visible, so each parent can access this for their child/children.

Facebook:

- We will endeavour to add more information to the school's Facebook page, as well as adding this to the class dojo system.

Adult learning:

- Any adult learning courses and workshops will be advertised as much as possible through texts, letters and messages via social media, as well as during parents' evenings where appropriate. Spaces are usually extremely limited on these courses and workshops, but we will aim to get the message out as far as possible.
- More courses and workshops are being planned for the Spring and Summer terms after the success of our Christmas Wreath and Bauble making workshops.
- We will aim to carry out some of these workshops after school hours so that working parents also have the option to attend.
