
Staff who are leaving.

Attendance Holidays during term time

During this academic year we have lost **1011 teaching days (5055 lessons!) due to 98 children** being taken out of school for term time holidays. This is unacceptable and a serious concern for the school and could mean that the school could fail an OFSTED inspection based on the attendance factor alone. We want to work with our families and are seeking to be able to authorize up to 5 days holiday in exceptional circumstances. **If more than 5 days are taken then we will be taking steps to fine parents and it may mean that the children lose their place here at Belgrave.** This is the biggest issue the school faces and we can only deal with this by asking for your support and help. I will be meeting with every family that wishes to book a holiday to ask them to explain why it is necessary and for them to understand that this could be jeopardising the success of the school.
