Autumn Topic

Our topic this term is 'The Victorians' and we will be learning lots about historical events in Victorian times. As we encourage children to continue their learning at home it would be greatly appreciated if you could help your child research 'The Victorians' either on the internet or in books and make notes about what they have discovered to share with the whole class.

Wow Day

On Tuesday 10th September we will be launching our Victorian topic with a WOW day where the classroom will be transformed in a Victorian classroom for the day and the children in role will have a Victorian style lesson. To fully engage with this we are asking the children to come to school in Victorian style clothes.

Reading Folder

Children are asked to bring their reading book and diary into school everyday. Your child will be listened to once a week and will bring home a new reading book each week. They will also bring home spellings to learn each week which must be practiced at home. It is very important that you listen to your child read at home **each day**. The diary **MUST** be signed each day to show that you have read with your child.

Homework

One piece of homework will be sent out on a Friday and **MUST** be returned to school by Tuesday morning the following week. The homework given out to the children is designed to review work done in school and although we ask you to help your child please ensure they are doing the work.

PE Kits

PE lessons will take place on a Monday and Wednesday. Please ensure that your child has a full PE kit in school every day and that it is clearly marked with the child's name. In addition, please ensure that long hair is tied back and that all jewellery is removed on these days.
