The purpose of this addendum is to shift the cycle of the SPSA to align with the school year budget, LCAP, etc.

Goal 1- Improve school-wide student achievement and proficiency in Language Arts and Mathematics.

- The percentage of students meeting or exceeding standards on the CAASPP will remain constant or increase 1% in ELA and increase 3% in Mathematics.
- Continue to keep graduations rates above 95%
- Continue to keep or improve AP test pass rate at or above 65%

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Goal 2- English language learners will become proficient in English and math. During the 2018-19 school year, English learners will become proficient in English as evidenced by growth in CELDT scores, and improve growth in standards met or exceeded in the 2018 CAASPP ELA and math assessment scores.

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Goal 3- All students will be educated in learning environments that are effective, engaging and safe at school. Effective instructional strategies will be included in Common Core SS lessons, Response to Intervention through Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) and using restorative justice practices to support student needs in solving conflicts and reducing student suspensions.

Changes	All students will receive Tier 1 Social/ Emotional Education using the Character Strong curriculum and complete a Social Emotional screener.
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Goal 4- Students will develop college and/or career plans and participate in productive activities which further develop students as Academic Achievers, Community Contributors, and Effective Communicators. All students will graduate RHS college and/or career ready. They will have the technological skills necessary to be successful in their college and/or career paths.
