BENCHING

This is a “Bring Your Own Cage” show. Each cat will be allotted a 48" space to bench in. We are not providing cages. Carry pop up tents are available at [Walmart](#) and Target if you need one. The two sides, back, and top of the cage must be covered. Cat litter will be provided, but please bring your own litter pan, food and water dishes. Per TICA Show Rule 26.1.2 “No more than two kittens or one cat may be benched in a single cage, whether entered for competition, exhibition or for sale.” The Entry Clerk will attempt to honor any benching requests.

SHOW HALL

The show hall is a new facility built in 2016. It is climate controlled and handicapped accessible. No smoking will be allowed in the building. We will have concessions.

HOTEL

We have a room block at the La Quinta Waxahachie, 311 Stadium Drive, Waxahachie, TX 75165. The hotel is 15 min from show hall. The room rate is a reduced to \$85 per night and includes fresh hot breakfast, internet, parking, and NO pet deposit. There is a Courtyard by Marriott located at the conference center; however, their rate is much higher and we were not able to negotiate a better deal. If staying there, please verify you will be able to keep a pet in the room.

Feline PAW will use the TICA Hotel Room Inspection Procedures for exhibitors who lodge at the La Quinta Waxahachie using the club's group booking. See Standing Rules 903.7. Entry in this show, and lodging at La Quinta using the club's group booking, shall constitute an acknowledgment by and consent of the exhibitor to these procedures.

AIRPORT

Dallas Love (DAL) and Dallas Fort Worth International airport (DFW) are both about 35 miles (40 minutes) from the show hall. Neither the hotel nor the club provides pick up service from any of the airports. Uber fare estimate is between \$35 - \$50 each way.

SHOW RULES

TICA show rules will be strictly enforced. Any person entering a cat or kitten in a TICA sponsored show shall agree to abide by and uphold the Rules of this Association. TICA Show Rules, registration information and forms may be requested from TICA, P.O. Box 2684, Harlingen, TX 78551 or 956-428-8046 or downloaded from TICA's [website](#).

REGISTRATION

Cats shown in this show need to be TICA registered or eligible for registration in TICA. The following classes must be TICA registered in order to be entered in the show: Preliminary New Breed, Advanced New Breed, and New Traits. All cats shown in the Kitten, Championship, and Alter classes must be TICA registered or eligible for registration. If not registered, proof of registration eligibility is required to enter the show. Contact the entry clerk for more information on how to enter your cat, kitten, or alter without a TICA registration number. Household Pets and Household Pet Kittens do not need to be TICA registered to compete. However, to be scored for TICA titles and Regional/International awards, all cats (other than household pet kittens) must be registered by their second show. If you have questions, please contact the Entry Clerk or TICA.

HEALTH

This is a non-vetted show. Any cat showing signs of illness, parasites or fungus will be escorted from the show hall, along with any cats owned, housed or agented by the same exhibitor. All entries should be vaccinated against feline viral rhinotracheitis, calici and distemper (panleukopenia) at least two weeks prior to the show, and should test negative for feline leukemia and FIV ("feline AIDS"). **Any feline from a house or cattery where there has been fungus or any infectious or contagious illness within 21 days prior to the opening day of the show is ineligible for entry.** An obviously pregnant or lactating cat will be disqualified. **Be prepared to show proof of rabies vaccination. It is state law.** TICA show rules require all claws, front and back, be clipped prior to judging.

CLERKS / STEWARDS

Clerks will be able to obtain Early Bird rate regardless of when they enter, will be paid \$35 per session, plus a fully marked catalog and lunch. Stewards will receive \$20 per ring per session and lunch. Please indicate in the TOES Comments section if you are interested. Do not deduct clerking fees from your entry. Requests for specific judges will be honored to the extent possible. Currently licensed TICA clerks will be given preference.
