Mike Harbour is the Deputy Chief Executive Officer of Sound Transit, a position he has held since October 2012. Mike moved to Sound Transit from Intercity Transit in Olympia, Washington. Mike served 17+ years as General Manager of Intercity Transit. During Mike's leadership, the agency won the American Public Transportation Association's (APTA) Outstanding Public Transportation System Award and achieved Gold Status in the APTA Sustainability Commitment program. Prior to Intercity Transit, Mike served over 8 years as General Manager of Chatham Area Transit (CAT) in Savannah, Georgia. CAT was also a recipient of APTA's Outstanding Public Transportation System Award. Mike also has worked at the Orlando, Florida transit system, the City of New Orleans Mayor's Office, the Nashville Metropolitan Transit Authority and on the central staff of ATE Management and Service Company.

At Sound Transit, Mike served two years as the Acting CEO and 6 months as acting Chief Human Resources Officer in addition to his role as Deputy CEO.

Mike is a graduate of Vanderbilt University with a Bachelor of Engineering degree and was in the graduate program in Civil Engineering – Transportation Planning at Northwestern University.
