## Spring Show - 25<sup>th</sup> April 2018

- 1. A patio container of mixed spring flowers.
- 2. A bowl of Primulas, any species. Bowl not exceeding 300mm.
- 3. A Hippeastrum in a pot.
- 4. A vase of spring flowers with foliage, home grown. Exhibitors' vase.
- 5. An arrangement in a basket( does not have to be home grown)
- 6. Three Rhododendron flower heads displayed on a board.

The J.Ferguson memorial trophy to be awarded to best exhibit from sections 1 to 6.

- 7. Two vases of Daffodils/Narcissi. One vase self colour, one vase bi-colour, 3 stems per vase.
- 8. One vase of cut Daffodils/Narcissi, three stems, each a different cultivar/species.
- 9. Five stems of cut dwarf Daffodils/Narcissi, same cultivar/species.

The Alan Unwin trophy to be awarded for most points in cut Narcissi. Classes 7, 8, 9.

- 10. Five stems of Tulips same species/cultivar.
- 11. Two vases of Tulips, three stems, different cultivar/species per vase.

The Win Hannah trophy to be awarded for most points in cut Tulips. Classes 10 and 11.

- 12. Two pots of dwarf bulbs, one pot Tulips, one pot Narcissi.
- 13. One pot of any dwarf bulb excluding Tulip and Narcissi.

The Tom Brown Memorial Trophy to be awarded for most points for bulbs in pots. Classes 12 and 13.

- 14. A photograph postcard size, mounted, not framed. Subject 'Bursting into bloom'
- 15. Three pieces of Parmesan and Rosemary shortbread.

Recipe

95g plain flour

100g grated Parmigiano Reggiano

100g salted butter (chopped)

1 tablespoon of chopped fresh Rosemary to serve

Preheat oven to 180°C

Method - place flour and butter in a bowl using fingers rub butter into the flour to form a crumbly dough. Add in the parmesan and rosemary. Roll the dough into a cylinder making sure each end is flat, wrap in cling film twisting the ends to form a seal. Refrigerate for at least 60 minutes. Line a tray with greaseproof/parchment paper. Use a sharp knife and cut into approx. 7mm rounds. Place biscuits on tray about 2cm apart. Bake for 10 - 13 minutes, remove when pale gold at edges. Cool before serving.

Pots not to exceed 225mm.

Judging will begin at 7pm prompt.
