Heading of Readings: Third Easter Sunday Year C

First Acts 5:27-32 In reply Peter and the apostles said "Obedience to God comes before man/ God raised up Jesus you (JEWS) hanged him from a tree/...raised to be leader and saviour/repentance and forgiveness of sins/ (apostles) witnesses to all this with the Holy Spirit/warned not to speak in the name of Jesus but glad for the honour of suffering humiliation for the sake of the name.

Psalm 29: I will praise you, Lord, you have rescued me/raised my soul from dead/his anger lasts but a moment, his favour through life/changed my mourning into dancing/ I will thank you for ever.

Second: Apocalypse 5:11-14 The Lamb that was slain is worthy to be given praise, honour, glory and power.

Gospel: John 21:1-9 Jesus steps forward, took the bread and gave it to them, and the same with the fish. After the meal Simon Peter proclaims his love for Jesus three times and is instructed to "Feed my lambs/feed my sheep"

Following the terrible attacks on Easter Sunday at churches in Sri Lanka, His Eminence Malcolm Cardinal Ranjith, the Archbishop of Colombo, and Father Tadeusz J Nowak, OMI, the Secretary General for the Society for the Propagation of the Faith in Rome, are appealing to Catholics worldwide for emergency funds to help rebuild lives of those affected and the damaged Churches in Sri Lanka.

The EU Settlement Scheme and how to apply

The UK Government has launched the EU Settlement Scheme offering EU citizens living here a legal route to remain.

EU (European Union), EEA (European Economic Area) and Swiss citizens living in the UK must apply if they are to protect their existing rights and their place in our society.

Irish citizens or those with valid indefinite leave do not need to apply. It is free to apply, and the scheme will remain open until 30 June 2021.

We ask all Catholic parishes, schools and organisations to bring the settlement scheme to the attention of all who need to avail of it and also to be aware of vulnerable people who may not realise they need to apply. In particular we encourage you to signpost people towards the official website page on the settlement scheme here: <https://eucitizensrights.campaign.gov.uk/>, and the official helpline for the settlement scheme 0300 123 7379.

Finally, we urge the whole Catholic community to take up Pope Francis' call to welcome, protect, promote and help to integrate everyone who has made their home here.
