Our Methodology

Over the years Languages.lu has built its reputation with an innovative and unique approach to teaching.

The emphasis is based on natural and spontaneous communication which helps the juniors:

- on one side, acquire and revise vocabulary and grammar, improve their oral expression and interaction, and
- on the other side, practice the language through creative, musical and cultural activities, which are adapted to and incorporate the students' passions and interests.

Thanks to our language courses, your children can meet and interact with other children from different countries and cultures. They have fun together while learning, practicing a foreign language and developing their communication skills in a different language than their mother tongue.

In addition, all our language programmes are developed with the greatest attention to the prerequisites outlined by the European Common Reference Framework for Languages, which are valid in all European countries.



Although it appears to be a contradiction to the development in recent years of the means of communication, our children now have less time and fewer opportunities to play and communicate with each other. This situation has created with an increasing burden of homework, more time spent in front of their TV, I-Pads, laptops and other IT gadgets. Our generation of children devotes less and less time to each other, and this means that sometimes they don't develop some of the fundamental communication skills.

Our Language CAMPS

During all school holidays - From 6 to 18 years old

Our camps are conceived to allow the juniors to discover the practical side of the language, to help them gain confidence in themselves and to communicate better, to make new friends and have a great fun during the school holidays.

The discovery of the language is made through activities that are fun, interesting, educational and practical, and which are adapted to the group's age and language level.

We do not recreate the stressful and competitive school environment, but rather allow the juniors to advance at their own pace.

Our camps are offered during all school holidays in Luxembourg, France, Germany and Belgium:

- ■ Carnival
- ■ Easter
- ■ Pentecost
- ■ Summer holidays
(from mid June to mid September),
- ■ All Saints,
- ■ Christmas.



The activities may include cooking activities to learn the fruits and vegetables vocabulary and to introduce international recipes from each other's country, different handicrafts such as masks, jewellery and origami creations. Children can learn about the 7 wonders of the world, role play birthday parties, write and act out short plays or soap-opera episodes, watch and comment on suitable movies.

Teenagers could learn and debate about leadership, cultural resemblances and differences, importance of self-confidence, play outdoor games that encourage both team spirit and communication skills in the acquired language...

N.B. Please note that the camps are not the equivalent of school tutoring. Our camps focus on oral communication, in order to allow all participants to express themselves and gain confidence.

Should your child have specific problems in school with grammar rules, pronunciation etc, we recommend you to let him join our individual school tutoring programme.

A discount of 25 EUR / child is offered for the registration in a second full time camp by the same participant or by 2 siblings, if the registration and the payment for the full time camps are made at the same time.

For our day camps we may also offer accommodation with host families. Please contact us for details.

Registration procedure

The registration shall be exclusively done in writing by sending us the registration form and the declaration of responsibility either by e-mail (info@languages.lu) or by post (Languages.lu / c/o Group Moraru – 6, rue Marguerite de Brabant L-1254 Luxembourg – Merl, to the attention of Inès Chrétien).

The registration form should be accompanied by the proof of payment, clearly stating the child's name.

In addition to the bank transfer (in favour of Group Moraru sàrl, BIC/SWIFT Code: BGLLULL, Bank account: LU42 0030 6491 2434 0000), you can pay in cash at our reception.

Please note that the registration closes 2 weeks before each starting date.

Schedule and prices

The camps start at 9.00 a.m. and finish at 5.00 p.m.

If necessary, we can provide from 8 am until 9 am and from 5 pm until 6 pm an extra hour of child care for a supplement of €15/ h/ child.

The price of the full time camp does not include lunch. Please provide the necessary food and beverages, depending on your child's diet and needs.

REMINDER : If less than 3 children are registered per group, the number of hours will be automatically reduced.



Cancellation policy and refunds

Cancellations are accepted only in writing.

In case of cancellation received more than 41 working days, the refund is 100%.

In case of cancellation 22 to 40 working days, the refund is 75%, and in case of cancellation 11 to 21 working days, the refund is 50%.

No refunds or fee reductions can be made for cancellations received 10 or less working days before the starting date of the camp or in case of no written cancellation and absence the first day of the camp.
