ARTICLE VII. RISK MANAGEMENT

SECTION I. ALCOHOL POLICY

The Alcohol Policy of IFC presents a policy in an effort to take a more responsible position on alcohol related events and protects our fraternities, as well as their members. The following has been recognized and endorsed by the Interfraternity Council and will be implemented immediately to be policy:

- A. Hard alcohol, or any alcoholic substance with an alcohol content by volume (or ABV) exceeding 15%, is to be strictly prohibited at IFC chapter facilities during any time at which an event is being held.
- B. The policy applies to all social, alumni, brotherhood, or any other chapter sponsored event, served both by BYOB and/or 3rd party vendor.
- C. The policy will be reviewed on an annual basis, prior to the end of the school term.
- D. Failure to abide by this policy will result in an IFC judicial board process where appropriate sanctioning will be determined.

Any questions about social functions or any specific alcohol policy should be referred to the Social Event Guideline Policy of Sorority and Fraternity Affairs.
