Two papers presented at the Combined Sections Meeting of the American Physical Therapy Association in Las Vegas in February confirmed Kickstart's potential as both a walking aid and a therapeutic tool, demonstrating that Kickstart users improved their walking while wearing Kickstart and, after several months of use, were also able to maintain many of those improvements, even when walking without Kickstart.
