

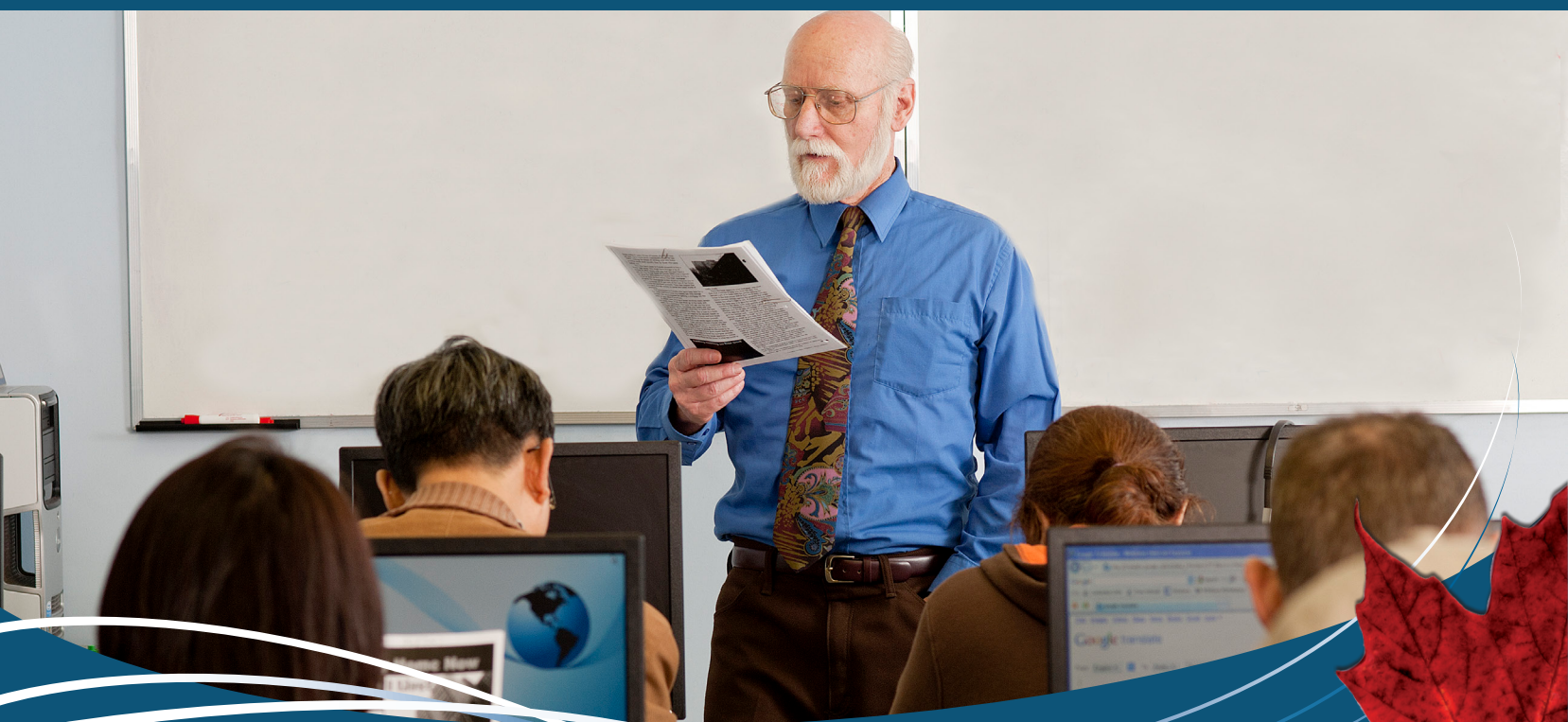

Immigrants With Occupation Related Knowledge (IWORK) program provides workplace focused language training to newcomers/immigrants who are assessed at Canadian Language Benchmarks (CLB) 3+ and are looking to find entry level jobs.

Canadian Workplace Culture and Communication

This course is designed to equip participants with the essential communication skills needed to succeed in a diverse and highly competitive professional Canadian workplace.

Computers for the Workplace – Basic

This course is designed to help learners improve their English and master basic computer functions such as sending and receiving e-mails, navigating the web and creating simple documents in Word, Excel and PowerPoint.

This course is specially designed to develop essential business communication skills in English and equip participants with thorough knowledge of business practices in Canada and the steps involved in running your own business.

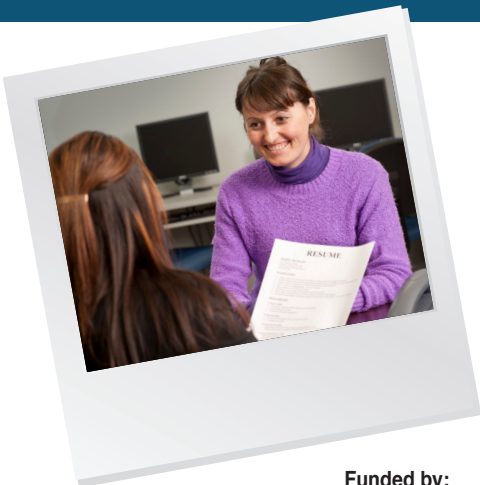
English for the Service Industry
