PROGRAM

- Resident Firefighters will be enrolled in the Wenatchee Valley College Fire Science Program.
www.wvc.edu/academics/fire-science/index.html
- A Firefighter Recruit Academy is included in the Fire Science Program.
- The academy includes IFSAC Firefighter 1, Firefighter 2, HazMat Awareness and HazMat Operations training. IFSAC testing is provided through the district.
- Upon completion of the Academy, Resident Firefighters will be assigned to a shift.
- College Tuition Reimbursement, IFSAC and EMT Certifications, a monthly stipend, housing at one of the District's fire stations and compensation for incident response are included in the Resident Firefighter Program.

SELECTION PROCESS

- Resident Firefighter applications can be picked up in person at Station 10 at 136 South Chelan Avenue, Wenatchee WA 98801 or request an electronic version from 509.662.4734
- Qualifications required for consideration:
 - Must be 18 years of age
 - High School Diploma or GED
 - Possess and maintain a valid driver's License with acceptable driving record
 - Pass the department's physical agility test and medical evaluation

- 2019 Firefighter Recruit Academy starts in September. Applications received before June 14th will be given preference, selection will be on-going as we receive applications.
- If interested in joining our program, submit your application along with a cover letter and any photocopies of relevant certificates or diplomas to our administrative office.

Upon successful completion of the two year program, Resident Firefighters will have the experience and certifications necessary to competitively test for career firefighter positions.
