Pastor Langknecht opened the meeting with prayer.

Call to Order: President Kiffe called the meeting to order declaring a quorum present at 7:35 p.m.

Approval of Minutes: A motion by Brenda Rian to accept the Church Council Meeting minutes of March 20, 2017 was seconded. **Motion carried.**

Reports: The Ministry Activity Reports were emailed to Church Council, committee chairs, and staff on May 14, 2017.

Pastor: Pastor Langknecht said that June 4, 2017 will be Affirmation of Baptism Sunday which welcomes new members into the church. Pastor will coordinate the instruction and orientation of those interested in joining the church. On June 11, 2017, only one service will be held in Lake Fairfax at the church picnic. Pastor suggested that an Ad Hoc Committee be assembled including himself, Brenda, and another volunteer to decide the policy of the church for handling people who drop in and request financial aid. Pastor is meeting with the Mutual Ministry and Staff Relations Committee this week and will have recommendations after this occurs. A motion by Allen Wild to continue with two services during the summer except for the June 11, 2017 picnic service at Lake Fairfax at 11 a.m. **Motion Carried.**

Vice President: Doug Gaibler reported that work continues on getting bids for the changing of the phones and internet service vendor.

Treasurer: Bob Unger commented on the treasurer's report that was emailed to council members on May 1, 2017. It was suggested by a council member that quarterly financial reports be send to church members. A motion by Allen Wild to move \$500 from Bank Fees to Stewardship was seconded. **Motion Carried.** Mary Beth Alford is leaving and Allen and Bill Hiatt will debrief her and the Mutual Ministry will advertise the position.

Congregational Life: Brenda Rian suggested that a person be available at the end of each service if any church member would like to stay and pray. She will see if this can be arranged.

Nominating Committee: Bill Carbaugh reported that Luke Catherine volunteered to serve as Worship and Music Chairperson until he leaves for seminary. A motion by Brenda Rian that the Church Council approve the appointment of Luke Catherine as Worship and Music Chair through June 2017 or until he leaves was seconded. **Motion Carried.**

Unfinished Business: The Congregational Meeting will be on June 4, 2017.

Adjournment: A motion by Brenda Rian to adjourn at 9:05 p.m. was seconded. **Motion Carried.**
