





concern about noise impacting (prey)

NOISE 2

- Concern about recourse if actual noise is worse than predicted in noise study.
- Mumeric Standards and noise disturbance Standard are both considered as part of noise Ordinance.
- For this proposal, residential Standards for noise apply (see county website)
- Noise of traffic AND animals themselves are a concern. More VISITS = more cars = more noise
- Concern about noise from special events (weddings, DJ's etc.) this would be camping
- Where will you measure sound from and how. Specific to the acoustics & setting.
- Want to be able to verify & validate information from noise study.

NOISE

- Want information about noise study (when, how, findings) and what happens with that
- Concern with proximity - home close to 1/4 mile from existing shop.
- Sound travels beyond 1/4 mile
- Acoustics impact/amplify noise
- On East side - sound may travel far. Can hear coyotes currently / some occasionally
- Value quiet that currently exist
- Without A.C. windows are often open - sound could come right in.
- Curious about current levels of noise. Have experienced quiet.
- Concern about howling/barking impacting other pets - may spook more local barking → livestock.
- With traditional uses (horses, ranches) concern about noise impacting (prey)

NOISE 2

WILDLIFE / ANIMALS

- Elk migration comes through this area. Wolf presence may deter. → Specific Property
- Other wildlife (deer, turkey, bear, moose, bobcats etc) may be impacted. - on property now
- People come here because of wildlife. Would hate to lose them.
- Additional traffic will impact wildlife.

NOISE 3

- Want solid baseline of current noise AND actual impact w/ changes.
- Interest in helping (biting local knowledge) with noise study.
- An option could be de-barking animals or bark collars.
- Noise would really impact health/wellbeing of some resident.
