Effective January 1, 2017

Charge: \$0.25/lb

- Cement/Mortar/Plaster
- Latex Paint
- Antifreeze

- Cooking Oil/Grease



Charge: \$0.25/bulb

- All light bulbs




Charge: \$1/unit

- Battery, Automotive (lead acid)



Charge: \$5/unit

- Microwave



Charge: \$15/unit

- Dehumidifier
- Miniature Refrigerator
- Small A/C Unit
- Small Water Cooler
