Registration fees are payable by cash or card at the time of registration.

PETITE CLASS SELECTIONS

STUDENT AGE AT 1/1/18	CLASS OPTION	
2-3 years	Mummy & Me A dance class for toddlers who are walking and talking but aren't quite ready to be in a class without mummy (or daddy or a carer) just yet. Parent/carer stays with their child to encourage and guide through class activities.	
3-5 years	Tutu Tap & Twist A special class designed specifically for our younger dancers, Tutu Tap & Twist combines elements of ballet, tap and jazz to encourage movement quality, musicality, self confidence and, most importantly a love of dance. Students in this class are required to have ballet, tap and jazz shoes as the class covers all three styles.	

FEES

Payment of classes is based on a <u>term fee</u> and the amount of classes students do per week (classes for the Petite age group consist of ½ hr or ¾ hr lessons).

Invoices will be emailed out to each student/family at the start of each term with fees due in **Week 3**. Any families, who will have difficulty in paying the term fees, please speak to Miss Chelsea, as other arrangements may be made.

There are <u>NO REFUNDS</u> on any missed lessons (class packages). If students do happen to miss a lesson they may make-up a class by attending another class (any style). If students are long term sick, please provide us with a medical certificate.

Fees can be paid by cash or card at the studio, by direct deposit or via PayPal through our Parent Portal.

NEW students in our Petite Classes (Mummy & Me + Tutu Tap & Twist) are eligible for **one FREE** trial class (*new students only*). If you then choose to register you will be charged for the remainder of the term plus the applicable registration fee.
