Trip Itinerary

Jan 2 Arrive in San Jose. Your private guides will meet you at the airport and take you to Hotel Bougainviella, where you can explore the hotel's beautiful gardens.

Jan 3 Poas Volcano Park There are few places in the world where you can almost touch the rim of an active volcano. After a short hike through the cloud forest, you end up looking down into a smoking crater.



A short drive takes you to the **La Paz Waterfall Gardens**. If you think about Costa Rica, you probably imagine lush rain forest, flowing rivers, waterfalls, birds, butterflies, monkeys, hummingbirds, snakes, felines and frogs. Waterfall Gardens has all of this and more. Delicious buffet lunch included.



Next stop is the Selva Verde Ecological lodge. Their vast forest is filled with biodiversity, perfect for bird and wildlife watchers. The comfortable lodge offers excellent dining and even swimming pools where you can relax with a drink while you admire the forest.



Jan 4 Wake up bright and early for **fly fishing** at the Sarapiquí River with Lazaro Reyes. Organizer of the only annual fly fishing tournament in Costa Rica, Lazaro is the country's most knowledgeable fly fishing guide. For those not fishing, Lloyd will lead you a tour of the incredible Selva Verde rain forest.



Jan 5 On your way to La Fortuna, you will stop in the town of Venecia for a reception in your honor. Interact with locals and learn about their food and culture.

That evening you will dine and bathe at **Ecotermas Hot Springs**, a locally owned complex where you can try out the pools, fed by the region's abundant natural hot springs.

Overnight at the Montana del Fuego Hotel.



Jan 6 Hanging Bridges Tour. Explore the rain forest from below, above, and in between. Your expert guides will lead you through this lush rain forest, where the diversity of this ecosystem is always on display. Free **afternoon** to take an optional tour. Dinner in town.

Jan 7 Drive to **Hacienda La Pacifica Hotel**, a working farm in the town of Cañas. Along the way you will enjoy beautiful views of Arenal Volcano and Lake.

Jan 8 Fishing day at Tenorio River with Lazaro. This six hour tour will take you along this beautiful river in search of Machaca, Robabo and Guapote.



Those not fishing will enjoy a **wild-life tour at the Bebedero River**. The lowlands and marshes of Palo Verde National Park host the largest concentration of waterfowl and wading birds in Central America.

From the comfort your boat, you will also be able to see to see crocodiles, iguanas, coati mundi and monkeys. Afternoon visit to Llanos del Cortez Waterfalls.



Jan 9 Fishing will continue, this time along the Corobici River where Machaca are abundant. Sometimes called "mini tarpon," Machaca are one of the most aggressive and hardest fighting fresh water fish in Costa Rica.

Those not fishing will travel to Rincon de la Vieja National Park. This tour includes a morning walk past boiling mud pods and through dense tropical forest. After lunch, you will take a second hike to a spectacular waterfall

Jan 10 Flight back home from Liberia airport
