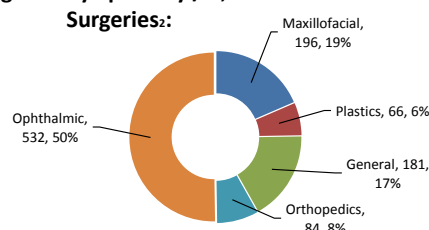
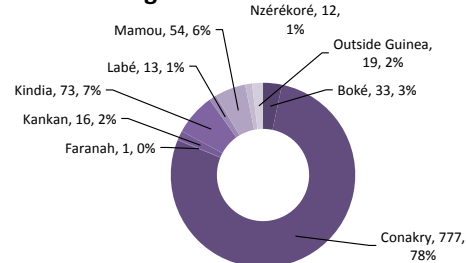

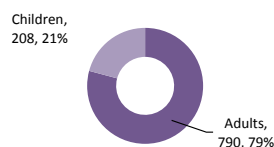
### Surgeries by Specialty / 1,059



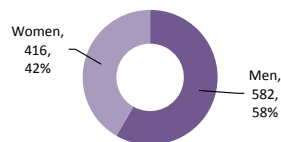
### Patients - Region

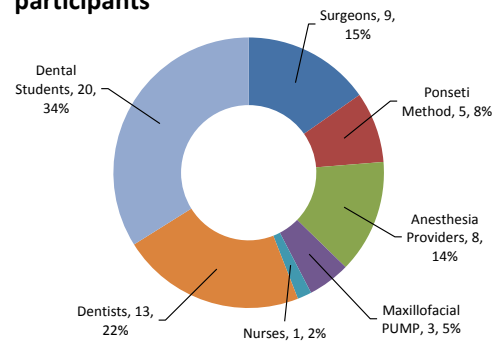

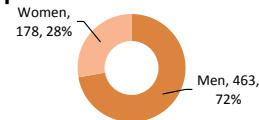

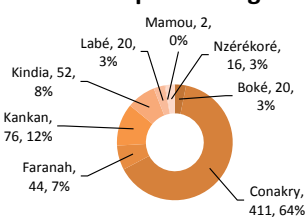
## Mentoring - 59 participants



## Participants - Gender



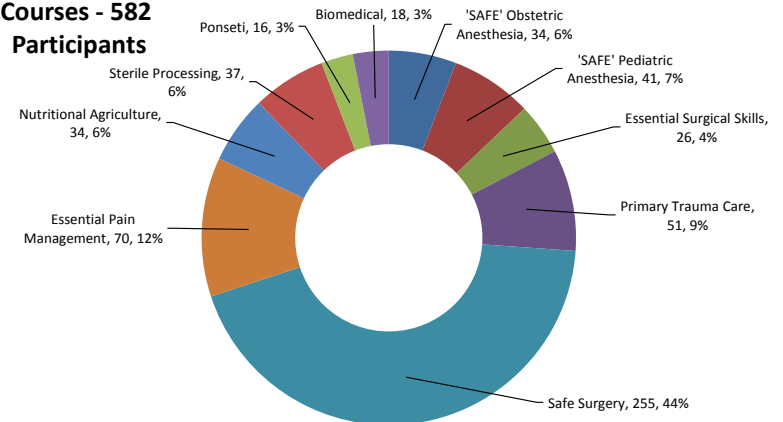
