EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 243 622

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111
Spill or leak	DO NOT touch or walk through spilled material. Wear PVC overalls, chemical resistant gloves, boots, facemask or goggles. Prevent further spillage. Small spills: Collect spilled product and place in sealable container for disposal. Spill residues may be cleaned up using water plus detergent. Seek advice from the Local Authority or the SDS or product label regarding disposal. Larger spills: Report large spills to 0800 CHEMCALL (0800 243 622).
Fire	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Fumes and combustion products produced in a fire may be toxic and/or irritating. Small fire: Use dry chemical, CO ₂ , water spray or foam. Large fire: use foam, alcohol foam or water fog. If safe to do so, move undamaged containers from the fire area. Deny unnecessary entry. Do not allow material of run-off to enter waterways.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed	Give 2 glasses of water to drink. Consult a physician. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Do not give alcohol.
If in Eyes	Immediately flush eyes with water; remove contact lenses if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue flushing eyes for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists..
If on Skin	Wash affected areas with soap and water. Consult a doctor if irritation persists. Remove and wash contaminated clothing thoroughly before re-use.
If Inhaled	If affected, remove from contaminated area to fresh air.. Seek medical advice.

STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY

Storage: Store in original container, tightly closed, in a cool, dry, ventilated place away from direct heat or direct sunlight. May be stored in an unheated building. Store away from foodstuffs, animal feed, fertilisers, seeds, children and animals. Keep container sealed when not in use. See product label for further handling & storage precautions relative to the use of this product.
