

What is SBSCH?

The Small Business Superannuation Clearing House (SBSCH) is a free service you can use to make super guarantee (SG) contributions.

Businesses with 19 or fewer employees or an annual aggregated turnover of less than \$10 million are eligible to use this service. Your business can pay required SG contributions as a single electronic payment to the SBSCH, the payments will then be distributed to each employee's super fund.

The SBSCH allows you to pay using the SuperStream method, with money and data being sent electronically. It also enables you to nominate a regular contribution amount for an employee, make all super contributions in one transaction, access your transaction history and ensures all your SG obligations are met as



soon as your payment and instructions are accepted by the SBSCH.

You can access SBSCH through the Business Portal (BP) if you are a business with an ABN, or ATO Online Services using myGov if you are a business or sole trader with

an ABN or withholding payer number (WPN) but no BP account.
