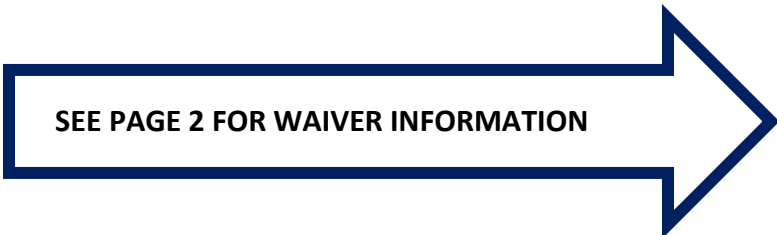


AP Exam Payment Table

- Please use the chart below to determine the price of exams (all discounts are taken into consideration, including family and AVID discounts).
- All exam payments are due by November 1st, 2019.**

- If you are eligible for a waiver (see the next page), you do not need to pay for AP exams, but you must turn in the appropriate waiver form to Mr. Lipton to complete the waiver process.
 - If you do not meet the criteria for a waiver but may need additional funding, please contact Mr. Lipton in the testing office to discuss funding options.
- The Late Window: November 2nd through March 13th**
 - If a student registers for AP exams during the Late Window, **a \$40 late fee per exam will be applied.**
 - If a student registers for an exam before November 1st but decides to cancel the registration during the Late Window, students will only receive a refund of \$54 per exam (original cost minus the \$40 late fee).
 - PLEASE NOTE: if a student who receives a waiver cancels their exam during the Late Window, the \$40 late fee will still apply to that student even though (s)he did not pay for the original exam(s).



CRITERIA TO DETERMINE A WAIVER

- _____ My student is eligible for the free and reduced meals program (FARMS).

- _____ My family receives assistance under Part A of Title IV of the Social Security Act.

- _____ My student is eligible to receive medical assistance under the Medicaid Program under Title XIX of the Social Security Act.

- _____ My student is a member of a family whose taxable income for the preceding year did not exceed 185% of the poverty level as established by the US Census Bureau. The table to the right lists family incomes by family size at 185% of the poverty level.
