

With camping here, Country officials said that it is critically important that these metal tanks be disposed of properly and offered a list of locations to safely take them.

According to a report by MLive, Kent County Department of Public Works Director Darwin Baas an employee "caught some of the concussion" but did not suffer any serious injuries and was released from hospital that day.

"We're fortunate that there were no serious injuries or no serious damage at this time," he was reported to have said.

The report added that Baas had said propane tanks have been an issue for the facility in the past. "It's almost like it's not if, it's when... These small ones, they get covered by newspaper or a corrugated box... There's just no way to see them going through the line."

"As much as people want to recycle as much as they can, these are things we can't and don't want at the recycling center," he was reported to have said.
