K. Children's Hunter-

- Open to junior riders on horses.
- Fences 3'.
- May not cross enter into the Pre-Children's Hunter at the same show.

L. Adult Amateur Hunter-

- Open to amateur riders on horses.
- Fences 3'.
- May not cross enter into the Pre-Adult Hunter at the same show.

M. Adult Equitation-

- Open to adult amateur riders
- Fences 2'6" or 3'

N. Equitation 14 and Under

- Open to Riders 14 years old and under.
- Fences 2'6" of 3'

O. Low Hunter-

- Open to any rider on horses or ponies. Fences 3'.

P. Junior/Amateur Owner-

- Open to junior and amateur riders on horses.
- Fences 3'3"-3'6".

Q. Green Hunter-

- Open to horses and ponies in their first or second year of showing over fences exceeding 2' and any rider. Adults may ride ponies.
- Fences 2', 2'6" or 3'.

R. Performance Hunter- (PREVIOUSLY WORKING HUNTER)

- Open to any horse or rider.
- Fences 3'3"-4'.

S. Ground Rail Eq.

- Open to amateur and junior riders who have not shown over fences.
- Courses must be trotted. Cantering will be heavily penalized.
- Riders may not cross enter into any other recognized ETHJA division or will forfeit eligibility.
- To be judged on riders' ability to effectively control the horse and equitation.
- This division will consist of three of four classes. Two or three over poles classes and one walk/trot under saddle. Any number of classes may be offered at any shows at the management's discretion.

T. JUMPERS- Any USEF table applies. See USEF rules, JP100-152.

a. Low Jumpers-

- Fences under 1.0m (3'3")
- Open to any horse/ pony rider combination which has never shown in any ETHJA or USEF jumper competition over fences 1.0m (3'3") or higher.

b. High Jumpers-

- Fences 1.0m (3'3") or higher
- Open to any horse/pony rider combination.

- There shall be no schooling allowed over the posted jumper courses just prior to the start of the class. Jumper courses must have a designated start/finish line.

CLASS DEFINITIONS

A. Beginner Rider Hunter/ Green Hunter

- Open to amateur or junior riders on horses or ponies who have not shown over fences above 18".
- Riders may enter other classes with fences 18" and any under saddle that is walk/trot only.
- Flat class to walk and trot.
- Fences 18". Courses may be trotted, trot in canter out or cantered. Simple changes not to be penalized.
- To be judged as a hunter class with emphasis on a riders' control and consistency in rhythm and strides.

B. Beginner Rider Equitation

- Open to amateur or junior riders on horses or ponies who have not shown over fences above 18".
- Riders may enter other classes with fences 18" or below and any under saddle class that is walk/trot only.
- Flat class to walk and trot.
- Fences 18". Courses may be trotted, trot in canter out or cantered. Simple changes not to be penalized.
- To be judged as an equitation class with emphasis on a riders' position, control and consistency in rhythm and strides.

C. RG Mini Hunter-

- Open to any horse or pony and any rider.
- Under saddle to walk/trot only.
- Fences 18" or 2'.
- Courses may be trotted.
- To retain eligibility in Beginner Rider and Beginner Equitation, these riders must jump 18".

D. Pleasure Hunter-

- Includes the following 3 classes-
 - Walk-trot under saddle
 - Walk-trot-canter under saddle
 - Hunter hack- to be worked both directions of the ring at the walk-trot-canter and jump 2 fences at the judge's discretion at 18".
- To be judged as a pleasurable ride, manners and attitude to be taken into consideration.

E. Short Stirrup-

- Open to riders 12 years and under on ponies in their first or second year of showing over fences 2' or higher.
- Pony/rider combination may not enter the Pony Hunter division at the same show.
- Fences 2'.
- May be combined with the Long Stirrup division.

F. Long Stirrup-

- Open to amateur or junior riders of any age on horses or riders 13 years old or older on ponies in their first or second year of showing over fences 2' or higher.
- Fences 2'.
- Pony or horse/rider combination may not enter the Pony Hunter division or the Children's Hunter at the same show.
- May be combined with the Short Stirrup division.

G. 2' Equitation-

- Open to short and long stirrup riders
- May cross enter into any other equitation division otherwise qualified.
- Fences 2'

H. Schooling Hunter-

- Open to all horses or ponies and junior, amateur and professional riders. Adults may ride ponies. Fences 2' or 2'6".

I. Pony Hunter-

- Open to junior riders on ponies.
- Fence heights: Smalls 2', Mediums 2' or 2'6", Large 2'6".
- USEF rules to apply with the exception of fence height.
- Small ponies to be shown by juniors 12 years of age or younger. Medium ponies to be shown by juniors 14 years of age or younger. Large ponies shown by juniors under 18.
- At USEF shows, the Children's Pony division will count toward year-end points in this division.

J. Pre-Child/Adult- (PREVIOUSLY SPECIAL HUNTER)

- Open to junior/amateur riders on horses. Fences 2'6".
- May not cross-enter into the Children's Hunter or Adult Hunter at the same show.

Numbers will not be issued without a SIGNED OPEN CHECK lodged with the horse show secretary.

The entry form must include:

- All classes or divisions entered
- All mandatory signatures, including legal guardian in the case of a minor
- Organization membership numbers

Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specification of the current Sanctioning Assoc., will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Stabling

Stalls with doors are available. Initial bedding will not be provided. Reservations for stalls and shavings must be received by March 29.

Damage

All owners and exhibitors shall be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents, or employees to stalls, buildings, and other properties on the show grounds, and shall be billed accordingly. (This includes screw eyes or nails in the stalls)

Refunds

Full refunds will be given before the closing date for the stalls (March 29). After the closing date of stalls, stall fees are not refundable. After the shows start, with the official vet's certificate only. Full refund will be given minus a \$15 scratch fee and fee for the classes already held prior to notification of the horse show secretary, whether exhibited or not. Scratches must be made in the horseshow office on the official form. Refunds will be mailed within 30 days after the show.

Lunging

No lunging permitted in the show rings or schooling areas. Lunging only in designated area.

Schooling

Schooling in the show rings without permission is prohibited at all times \$100 fine for anyone caught in the rings before or after the show if rings have been closed.

Health Papers

A negative Coggins (last 12 months), Health Certificate and proof of Annual Vaccination is required.

Attire

Jackets will be worn for the hunter and equitation classes in the show rings. Riders will be allowed to show in tucked-in polo shirts in the jumper ring.

Non-Showing Horse

Horse or ponies not showing will be charged \$15 per show day fee.

Non-Negotiable Checks

Checks returned by the bank for any reason will be assessed a penalty of \$30 or 10% of the check amount, whichever is greater. Upon notification of a returned check, accounts will be given three days to make full payment, including the penalty, which must be paid in certified funds, cashiers check, or money order. Overnight mail service is advised in order to avoid notification of the sanctioning organizations for disciplinary action.

Motorized Vehicles/Golf Carts

Unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate any motorized vehicles, ATV's, motorcycles, golf carts, etc., on the show grounds. Failure to abide by these regulations will subject the exhibitor to suspension from the horse show.

Parking

Fire regulations prohibit all vehicles, including trailers, vans, and campers, from being parked in the stable areas. Vans and trailers will be allowed in the stable area only to load and unload. PARKING AREAS WILL BE DESIGNATED AND VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AWAY AT OWNERS EXPENSE.

Protective Headgear

All exhibitors must wear ASTM approved protective headgear with harness secured and properly fitted while riding in the designated schooling and exercise areas, the show ring, and while jumping anywhere on the show grounds. The sanctioning association encourages all riders to wear protective headgear passing or surpassing applicable ASTM standards with harness secured while riding anywhere on show grounds. It is the responsibility of the rider, parents, guardian, or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards and is properly fitted and in good condition.

Minor Exhibitors

Parent(s) or guardian(s) of a minor child shall hold the horse show management and the facility harmless from any injury to such minor. No minor child's entry will be accepted, or number issued unless a parent or legal guardian signs the entry. The signature of unrelated persons WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Dogs

All dogs must be under control and on a leash no longer than 10' while on show grounds. Loose dogs will be impounded and the owner will be charged a \$100 fine added to their entry fee.
