## **Worship Notes**

This morning, Bro. Robbie will begin a series of three final sermons about the church as he finishes up his last few Sundays as our senior pastor. Today's sermon will address one of the most important things to keep as a priority at TBC (and *must* be a high priority for the next pastor): the expository preaching of Scripture. The Word of God must remain integral and foundational in the life of the church, and it must be the single greatest and highest quality we must look for in our next pastor. We must ask ourselves of any man seeking the office of pastor whether he believes all of Scripture to be inspired, infallible, and authoritative and whether he intends to preach it to the full, preparing a feast every week with the Bible and the Bible alone as the menu!


With that in mind, we'll obviously sing about the Scriptures this morning. In particular, there are lessons that today's songs teach us about God's Word:

- 1. God's Word is infallible! We can sing "Standing on the Promises" with confidence, because God's Word is true! His promises will never fail!
- 2. God's Word is authoritative! We can sing "God Has Spoken by the Prophets" because it is *God* who speaks in His Word. The authority lies in the author, and what greater authority can we find?
- 3. God's Word is living! The choir can sing "Living Hope with O Praise the Name" and recognize that just as Christ is risen and alive, His Word, too, is living and active!
- 4. God's Word is life-giving! We can sing "Speak, O Lord" which speaks of the Bible as giving "food from Your holy Word."
- 5. God's Word is Christ-centered! We can sing "Show Us Christ" with the recognition that the Bible is ultimately a book about Jesus! We pray, knowing that He is there and that we want to see and understand more of Him through the pages of Scripture.
- 6. God's Word is lasting! We can sing "Ancient Words" with the confidence that God has preserved His Word! Just as His Word has existed for thousands of years and passed down to us, we can trust that it will continue. Not one jot or tittle of the Scriptures will pass away or fail!

So, let us sing with joy this morning! We truly have much about which to sing! God who gave us His Word is worthy of our praise!

### Inspirational Quote for the Week

Expositional preaching is preaching in service to the Word. It presumes a belief in the authority of Scripture-that the Bible is actually God's Word; but it is something much more than that. A commitment to expositional preaching is a commitment to hear God's Word-not just to affirm that it is God's Word but to actually submit yourself to it. The Old Testament prophets and the New Testament apostles were given, not a personal commission to go and speak, but a particular message to deliver. Likewise Christian preachers today have authority to speak from God only so long as they speak His message and unfold His words. As loquacious as some preacher may be, preachers are not commanded simply to go and preach. They are commanded specifically to go and preach the Word. That's what preachers are commanded to preach.
