Worship Notes

At times we cannot see the forest for the trees. One of my favorite stories illustrates this memorably.

Sherlock Holmes and Dr. Watson were camping and quickly fell asleep after a large, late meal. Several hours later, Holmes woke his trusty companion, Dr. Watson.

"Watson, look up at the sky and tell me what you see."

Watson, somewhat annoyed at being stirred, replied, "I see millions of stars."

"What does that tell you?"

Watson pondered for a minute.

"Astronomically, it tells me that there are millions of galaxies and potentially billions of planets."

"Horologically, I deduce that the time is approximately a quarter past three."

"Theologically, I can see that God is all powerful and that we are small and insignificant."

"Meteorologically, I suspect that we will have a beautiful day tomorrow."

"What does it tell you, Holmes?"

Holmes was silent for a minute, then spoke: "Watson, you fool! It tells me that someone has stolen our tent!"

Such is the case as we gather to worship today! We are in danger of missing the point in worship sometimes (myself included!). Psalm 147:1 informs our worship today: "Praise the Lord! For it is good to sing praises to our God; for it is pleasant, and a song of praise is fitting" (ESV). God tells us that "it is good to sing praises to our God; for it is pleasant!" There's something about worshiping our great God that is fulfilling. I think that is because we are doing what we were created to do!

Our first song simply encourages us to **"Praise Him! Praise Him!"**, for Jesus is our blessed Redeemer and worthy of praise! We'll also sing one of my favorite songs that describes God—**"Indescribable."** I love it because in the title it implies that there's no way that we could adequately describe the Lord! **"Not for a Moment (After All)"** will hopefully encourage us that we *can* praise the Lord as we experience the difficulties of life, knowing that God does *not* forsake His people! The choir will sing of the work of the Spirit in the life of the believer in **"Your Love Awakens Me."** If you are a follower of Jesus, it is due to the mercy of God in awakening you to new life. What a blessing that God does for us what we cannot do for ourselves! Finally, we'll end with a renewal of commitment to Christ, asking Him **"Jesus, Keep Me Near the Cross."**
